FAITH PROMISE MISSIONARY UPDATES

Lorow, Ken & Eilene - ABWE Director of Prefield Ministries

The Lorows begin by sharing about three weeks of training for missionaries. The first week was "Essential Missions Components" where they hosted 30 missionaries for a week of intensive training, which was inspiring and productive. Week two was "New Missionaries" where 29 new missionaries were appointed to being their prefield journey with ABWE. Then week three was "Current Training" where 22 missionaries participated in security and departure readiness training, preparing for their upcoming missions. **NOTE:** While these training sessions were being held at ABWE, the MK's (missionary kids) were here at NLC with ABWE's Member Care/MK Ministries team who educate/prepare the MK's for the mission field. They also provide the children with fun activities (with games in the gym as a favorite!). These future missionaries, their children, and the ABWE teams are all blessed to have NLC provide a facility that meets the needs of their ministries. After all this activity, Ken & Eilene were able to slow it down and spend time with their family - having everyone, including Eilene's parents, under one roof. At a conference last week, the Lorows had the honor of speaking. "This was a fantastic opportunity to share our vision and experiences with a wider audience of mission-minded individuals and church leaders. The conference provided a platform to discuss the vital role of continuous care for missionaries, ensuring they are not only sent well but are also nurtured spiritually as they carry out their vital work. Thank you for your continued partnership and prayers. It's through your support that we can collaborate with such dedicated churches and pastors, ensuring that the mission field is filled with well-equipped and spiritually sustained workers."

Rizzo, Tony & Becky - Youth Action Ministries

Operation Youth Safety Zone 2025 is how the Rizzos start their ministry update. "Our ministry is starting an exciting, exceptional support-raising goal of needing \$50,000 for our 2025 Youth Safety Zone Outreaches. We are raising this support to help cover the cost of holding 20 Youth Safety Zones throughout Philadelphia and its vicinity. This will allow us to minister effectively to over 1,000 students with the gospel and discipleship materials and programs. ... This will set us on an intense path of reaching youth for Christ." Becky is healing and showing signs of full recovery. The Rizzos ask to continue praying for Becky as she learns to manage her chronic illness of Lupus. Recently, through Kids Safety Zones, they have seen several dozen youths make decisions to follow the Lord in salvation with some taking the next step of baptism. Thousands have responded to the Youthfluential videos and digital communications, sharing the gospel in many different formats! Prayer requests include 1) praying for the health of both Tony and Becky, 2) Equipment - they have an "Amazon Wish List" for supplying the needs of the Safety Zones. Visit www.YouthActionMinistries.com, under the Youth Safety Zone page for information on how you can help, 3) Upcoming Youth Safety and Street Safety Zones this fall, and 4) Their "2nd quarter budget was short by 10%, \$2,700.00. Please remember us in your prayers for this need in our ministry. This shortfall directly affects our salary, which Tony has not taken this quarter."

Baldis, Tina - GPPD - Slovakia

Tina's summer update is all about the Girls' Camp and VBS Day Camp. The months leading up to the summer camps were filled with preparation, spiritually and physically. There was the writing of the materials for teaching at the girls' camp, much organization and preparing the ministry center for hosting 18 girls as campers with a total of 30 people (including food preparation). "Our desire for these girls' camps is to provide a loving family atmosphere and a place for God's Spirit to transform lives. Because of this, many of the girls felt very comfortable and were more open to discussions about Jesus." Half of the girls were local girls with whom Tina has weekly Bible studies with. All of the new girls who came were invited by the girls who came last year. One of the girls struggled with an anxiety problem and had never been to an overnight camp. She managed to last 3 days before going home. "It should be noted that she came from an atheist family, but it was her cousins who are believers that invited her. However, she really enjoyed the small group she was in and had deep discussions about God with her leader. Prayer requests include: 1) How to follow-up with discipleship for those girls who live out of the area, 2) Tina and her seminary student Irena who is passionate to learn more about biblical worldview, and 3) Safe travels for Tina as she comes to the States to finally see her niece! She will also be visiting some churches and attending Global Focus Week at Liberty University.

Hoagland, Ed & Annita, Mexico. City

Ed begins their update with "Unfortunately it didn't work out to do camps this year, but it looks like next year it will happen (I'm much more confidant about this than when I say maybe next year when talking about my Yankees and Dolphins)." They continue to look for more ways to get the gospel clearly presented to more people in Mexico. Recently a team of 20 people went to the state of Taumalipas where they did 2 VBS and 2 Manna Mania 2.0 presentations at 2 different locations. "God blessed their efforts with 33 salvation decisions. The two churches we worked with are now doing the follow-up." "Once every 2 weeks we're visiting different migrant camps that are being set up for thousands of people traveling by foot and trying to get into the USA. We want to take advantage of them being in our backyard by giving them food, drink, clothes and the gospel. Last week our evangelistic team of 11 went to another camp here in the city and saw 50 people make a profession of faith in Jesus Christ." There are big evangelistic events planned for the 24th & 25th of August. "Pray that God will help us get large crowds assembled and that they will haven an ear to hear. Pray that God will once again save souls. And I pray that God will do the same with you. God bless."

Serino, Nick & Darianne - Alaskan Arctic

The Serinos are safely back in Fairbanks following Nick's transplant procedure. '"It is finished" except for the recovery of my immune system which will take many months. Please pray for me to not get sick especially from infections and bacteria." Two weeks prior to their return, Nick didn't think he would be able to make the trip back. He was still feeling the effects of the high dose chemo he received on July 3rd. "Thanks to the prayers YOU God's people, the last week I start to feel a little better each day. So Almighty God once again made the way and we made it back, though exhausted." In Point Hope, VBS and Teen Camp went well through prayers and the hard work of Matt & Jennifer who have kept things going in the Serinos absence. Nick asks that we pray for him to be able to return to Point Hope by Labor Day. They will have to return to Phoenix for about a week in October for Nick to have another Bone Marrow Biopsy and PET scan. Following this trip, he will be put on a maintenance program for the rest of the year. 'There is no "cure" for this so prayer will be forever needed to keep it under control. As we all know from this past year HE IS ABLE!' The Serinos end with "It is impossible to say thank you to all of our churches and friends for the wonderful cards, letters and special offerings over the past 10 months! Of course most importantly all the PRAYERS! You all have made the difference and to God be the Glory! As always please never forget the needs in the High Arctic villages for laborers and victories in the lives of the people up here! It is a never ending battle! This battle will be won for the Glory of God! WE LOVE YOU GUYS!"

Rardin, Clint & Rhonda - Mexico City

The Rardins share that their attendance levels are at record highs for normal Sundays. "It has also been a joy to see new converts continuing to attend." Cynthia was saved last fall when she visited (she works every other weekend nearby). She has since been baptized, attends every weekend, comes out Thursdays, attend both RU programs on Fridays and also on Saturday in Tepito. Cynthia's mother now attends and for several weeks her dad has been attending. He "wasn't really interested in spiritual things. That is why she was surprised that after church two weeks ago, he went to one of our men in our church and asked about the things of the Lord, was dealt with, and was saved." A few weeks ago, a group of their soulwinners were not permitted to knock on doors due to traffic caused by a Pride Parade. "God used this misfortune as we knocked on doors in a neighborhood closer to our church and knocked on the door of a family who attended our very first evangelistic service that we held the Monday before our inaugural Sunday twenty years ago and for the several subsequent months." A few weeks later, the two daughters and the son of one, surprised the Rardins with a visit to the church. And the son asked to attend teen camp the following week. The Rardins end with "Again, thank you so much for your faithful prayers and the faithful support you send us."

Strayer, Hannah - ABWE - Togo

Hannah begins by sharing the vision they (herself and others at ABWE IHQ) have to see media teams in the ABWE structure serving their teams around the world. As of now, Hannah is the only one currently serving in this capacity. ABWE operates in over 70 countries, so only about 1/10 of the missionaries are covered right now. "Over 1,000 missionaries are ministering and there are not even 100 of them covered within our African teams. This is a HUGE need for the media team!" Hannah shares that she really enjoys teaching about subjects she has a passion for and seeing people "get it". 'This is God's grace in my life, and it is a blessing to be affirmed in it! To me it's really about teaching with intention not just to impart knowledge but nurture and grow a person technically and spiritually - to mentor. This is a HUGE desire for me personally! The desire to reach and the need for media missionaries are not haphazard. God has brought these two things together as clearly for me as He did when He connected my passion for media and my call into missions in 2015. ... Mentorship would allow me to not only "gain" a teammate but would allow me to exercise that gift of intentional teaching by imparting what I have learned to others. I would love your prayers as I seek to pair these two things together. Pray for wisdom as I work to establish a structure for a mentoring program on the field in hopes to grow ABWE's media ministry in Africa and beyond.' Hannah's prayer requests are: 1) The Zambia project now - Aug 31st, 2) Storytellers Sept 5-12, and 3) for more people to join our Durban team.

Caputo, John & Kim - Gospel Furthering Fellowship - Campus Ministry

John begins their update by sharing about going "International". Travis Foster, who was saved through their university outreach 10 years ago has been in quite a few foreign countries preaching and teaching the Gospel. For the last 3 years or so, he has been ministering in Thailand seeking to help establish a God honoring church, which would be the only church existing in the area. To help accelerate this outreach, Travis asked John & Kim to come to Thailand to "help him establish a campus outreach to the only university in the area, which just happens to be close to the church plant effort! Since there is also a good number of English speaking Thai students there from influential families, this will be an excellent and strategic way to build the future church they are seeking to establish. Please pray for Travis, his new bride, Tiffany, and Kim and me as we begin to plan for this effort in the coming months." Recently John developed a program for his church to reach as many people as possible at an annual fair. "God saw fit to make our church outreach booth one of the busiest places in the whole fair. Please pray for the follow-up that will take place in the next two weeks." John also included an update on his cancer: 'I don't want to take a lot of time mentioning my need for prayer for my stage 4 prostate cancer situation, but a lot of people have been contacting me and looking for an update. So, I would definitely appreciate your prayers to be a good testimony to my family and continue being fruitful, for the Lord, during this time of trial. Since the diagnosis, more than 6 months ago, I regularly visit both my oncologist and my wellness medical doctor, who is an expert on alternative medicine to treat this condition. Other than tiring very easily, I am pain free and able to do my regular schedule for the most part. This illness has given me another "platform" to witness to many others at the various clinics and beyond. Please pray for the many therapies I'm doing, that they might extend my life and service to both my Lord and my family.






The Special Summer Sunday Nights at NLC will be held in the Chapel from 5:30-7 pm.
