FAITH PROMISE MISSIONARY UPDATES

Lorow, Ken & Eileen - ABWE Director of Prefield Ministries

The Lorows shared about their 30-day trip to South Africa, where they had the privilege of visiting their dedicated teams in Durban, Capetown and George. The trip was not just about travel, but a journey of deep connection, ministry engagement and spiritual encouragement. They were able to personally meet with all but two of their missionaries serving in the region. While in Capetown they had the opportunity to attend the East Africa Regional Conference. It was a time of rich fellowship and learning, where they could see the broader picture of how God is moving across the continent. The conference provided a space for our missionaries to be refreshed and encouraged, and we were grateful to be a part of that experience. Two of the photos included in their letter are of Hannah Strayer and the Ishlers. "As we reflect on these past few months, we are filled with gratitude for the way God has been at work. We're honored to be part of what He's doing through Prefield Ministries and excited for what's to come. Your prayers and support mean the world to us, and we're so thankful to have you on this journey with us."

Ishler, Darin & Kathy - Durban, South Africa

The Ishlers have returned home to Durban from their 2-month furlough. Prior to their furlough, a special Youth Sunday was held where the youth ran the entire service with singing, a skit, poem and preaching. It was a combined service with Crossroads and Sound Doctrine Fellowship. "God has been working in the hearts of these kids!" Several ABWE colleagues were able to visit and be part of this special day. In August, the Ishlers traveled to New York City to try applying for their SA visas. They were allowed to email several documents that were needed and were told that the NYC office did not have a backlog. In less than 2 weeks their visas were mailed to them! Praises are: 1) Their South African visas were granted for 3 more years; 2) They had an encouraging furlough; and 3) Alexis got her driver's license. Prayer requests are: 1) Tyler & Ella to have a great fall semester at college and 2) the health of Kathy's dad.

Hoagland, Ed & Annita - Mexico City,

"First I want to thank God for continuing to bless our work and effort we do for Him. Without Jesus, we can do nothing, it's all Him. Sometimes I feel so unworthy. I know there are others that work harder, they're smarter, speak better, have a better presentation, yet God continue to surprise me with His favor upon us. Thank you Father! Then I want to thank all of you who prayed for us. As I was taught: Nothing of any eternal significance ever happens apart from prayer. God answers prayers, and He definitely answered yours. You play an important part in this Mexican ministry. Thank You!" The last weekend in August, 5 Evangelistic Events (in a park, 3 times in a church building and on the street with a tent) were 736 people heard our gospel presentation and 114 made a profession of faith in Jesus Christ as their personal Savior (also had another person saved on the street on Saturday afternoon). "Not bad for a weekend. We praise God for what He did."

Baldis, Charles & Janet - Slovakia

"This summer (the months of July & August is summer in Europe) has been filled with surprises from God. More people have passed through our ministry center than ever before, including international students from Germany, Greece, Hungary and Serbia. God has been teach us to much through these lives, giving us direction for our Ministry Center here. We can see the need for biblical worldview training: having God's point of view for all of life. It begins with knowing the God of the Bible more intimately. We can also see the need for a bigger team in GPPD Slovakia. Therefore, we will be going to the States in September through December to visit our supports. We hope to raise funds and awareness of what God is doing in Slovakia." The Roma ministry is going well after trying for many months to get the cooperation of their village. The local school has rented a room to them (GPPD) for Nikola to teach and minister to her own people. They are thankful for the gifts to run this ministry, and are hopeful that God will continue to provide to keep this vital ministry going. Charles & Janet as us to continue to pray for: 1) Their travel to the States in September (scheduling for their travels); 2) Funds raised for GPPD Slovakia to expand the ministry there; 3) Funds to keep the Roma ministry going; and 4) Writing of the Worldview book.

Rizzo, Tony & Becky - Youth Action Ministries

"Our ministry is starting an exciting, support-raising goal of needing \$50,000.00 for our 2025 Youth Safety Zone Outreaches. We are raising this support to help cover the cost of holding 20 Youth Safety Zones throughout Philadelphia and its vicinity. This will allow us to minister effectively to over 1,000 students with gospel and discipleship materials and programs." At their most recent Youth Safety Zone, 40 kids joined the Rizzos along with their volunteers who made the event unforgettable! The best part was that five students made the life-changing decision to ask Jesus into their hearts!. Additionally, many Bible studies were shared, planting seeds for growth in faith. "Thank you to everyone who came out, served, and prayed over this event. Lives are being transformed for God's glory!"

Zuercher, Kirk & Julie - China Outreach Ministries

Over the past couple of years, Kirk, in his role as Director of Development, has been able to secure funding to assist with the startup costs for COM ministries that are begun on new campuses. As a leadership team, they have been praying that God would begin a new work in the lives of Chinese students and scholars on campuses where COM does not currently have missionaries working. God has been answering those prayers. In 2023, COM began working on the campus of Michigan State University and God has been so good in brining Chinese students to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ. Now, God is moving again as they have begun a new work on the campus of Georgia Tech. Recently, they interviewed a candidate to begin a new work on the campus of the University of Arizona in Tucson. God is doing a new thing and it is so exciting to join Him where He is working. Kirk & Julie love being grandparents to Noah (almost 3) and Jayden (just turned 1). They traveled to Utica to celebrate Jay's 1st birthday and then had the joy of bringing Noah back to their house for a week. It was the first ever "Gigi Camp". They had a great time with Noah and are already planning camp for next year for both Noah and Jay. "We would like to thank all of you who are already giving and praying so that we can be here doing what God has called us to do. You are truly a blessing to us and we thank God for you often. We are a team and God continues to do some amazing things. God bless!"

In January, the Aviation team (about 52 people) is having a Staff Conference in Mexico. Laurel and a co-worker are planning this event together. It is a time for the team to be away and together for fellowship and teambuilding. Laurel asks for prayer that the planning would come together smoothly.
