## Word of the Day: Law

## 1) The Law shows us what is a sin (Romans 3:19-20; 7:7)

# 2) The Law leads us to Christ (Romans 3:23-28; Gal. 3:24-25)

- The law cannot save us in any shape or form or is it something we add to the work of Christ to gain salvation.
- We are declared righteous not something we can achieve by works (Rom. 5:1; 8:1; Eph. 2:8-9)
- In Matthew 11:28-29 Jesus was showing the contrast of Himself and the Pharisees who tied up heavy burdens on the people. (Matthew 23:4)
- Every aspect of Christianity is about being with, in and through Christ
- · With Christ: Rom 6:8; 8:17; 15:5
- In Christ: Acts 24:24 Rom. 6:23; 8:1-2; 8:38-39; Col. 1:2-4; 1:28
- Through Christ: John 1:17; Acts 10:36; Rom. 1:8; 5:1; 5:1.

## 3) The Law shows us how to live.

#### 2 Timothy 2:4-6, Romans 13:9, 1 Corinthians 6:9-12

- The Law is good because it reveals God and the salvation that comes through Christ as well as His will.
- Because we want to please God we look to His law to find His will and live it out.
- · William D. Mounce says "The righteous have outgrown the Law."
- Romans 6:14-18 says that because of grace they are slaves of righteousness
- Righteousness (Made right with God) is a gift and a responsibility. (Rom. 3:21-31)
- Titus 2:14 says Christ redeemed us from lawlessness.

#### Who is the Law for?

- The law is for the unholy, the unrighteous, those who live lives inappropriate to their divine creator.
- Romans 2:15 the Law is written on their hearts.
- Those who strike their parents because the law demands we honor our parents (Ex. 20:12; Matt. 15:4; 19:19; Eph.6:2)
- Those who murder because the law says do not murder (Ex. 20:13; Matt. 15:19; 19:18)
- The Sexually immoral or Fornicators because the law says you shall not commit adultery (Exodus 20:14)
- Hebrews 13:4 says that the marriage bed should be kept pure and honored by all.
- 1 Thessalonians 4:6-7 God calls us to be pure and live Holy lives.
- Homosexuality because it is forbidden in Leviticus 18:22 and 20:13 see also Romans 1:24-27 and 1 Corinthians 6:9
- The Enslavers, Slave Traders, Kidnappers is forbidden in Exodus 20:15; 21:16 and Deuteronomy 24:7
- The Liars and Perjurers because it is forbidden in Exodus 20:16
- "Whatever is contrary to sound doctrine" (10)
- In accordance with the gospel of the glory of the blessed God with which I have been entrusted.
- · God is the source of all blessings

#### Closing

- The law reveals the character and nature of God which shows us where we have fallen short or what the Bible calls sin.
- The Beauty of the Gospel is that it is not about what we do or even what we have done but what Christ has done on our behalf.
- The Law shows us what sin is which leads us to Christ and reveals to us how to Live for Him.
- Christians look at the law differently because we are yoked together with Jesus in a relationship and therefore the Law shows us how to live not out of duty but out of love.
