Word of the Day: Guard/ Guarding

### 1) Guard the Truth of the Gospel

#### 1 Corinthians 15:1-8, Romans 10:8-13

- Like one who makes their deposit in the bank expects it to be protected we are called to make sure that the Gospel is not corrupted
- Guarding carries with it the idea of being active and is not seen as a passive task.
- Romans 3:23 we have all sinned and are separated from God.
- Hebrews 9:22 without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness of sins.
- Romans 8:3-4 and Heb. 10:3-18 Christ sacrifice did what no sacrifice could do. (God sized debt must have a God sized payment which is why the sacrifices in the O.T. were symbolism of what was to come)
- Romans 4:25 Jesus was offered for our justification.
- 1 Peter 2:22 Jesus was sinless therefore the only acceptable sacrifice.
- John 1:12 All who believe and receive Him become Children of God.
- Romans 6:23 and Ephesians 2:8-9 Salvation is a free gift. (cannot be earned)
- John 3:16 God Loved, God Gave, we believe, we receive.

# 2) Guard people from hearing false teaching

#### 2 John 7-11, 2 Timothy 2:16-18

- Matthew 7:15; Acts 20:28-29 Beware of False Teachers (Be alert to them)
- 1 Timothy 1:3 Timothy was to tell people to not teach a different doctrine.
- Romans 16:17-18 mark those who teach a different doctrine.
- Part of avoiding is watching your life and doctrine closely (1 Timothy 4:16)

## 3) Guard the Truth because their lives depend on it.

#### 2 Peter 2:1-2

- · swerved from the Faith
- It's the idea of missing the mark. (Shot wide of the faith)
- The unfortunate prophecy we have about the end times is that people will leave THE Faith. (2 Thess. 2:3; 1 Tim. 4:1; Matt. 24:10;Luke 8:13)
- Matthew 10:22 and 24:9 Jesus tells us we will be hated by the world
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 says we are to destroy arguments not the people.
- · Grace be with all of you
- · This cannot be done with your own strength
