1) False Teachers Have an Appearance of Godliness*Romans 1:16, Ephesians 1:13-14, Titus 1:16*

- Matthew 7:17 they are wolves in sheep's clothing
- Matthew 23:25-27 Jesus calls them white washed tombs because they looked good on the outside but were dead inside.
- Denying its power because they refused to believe the gospel message (1 Cor. 15:1-5)
- Acts 1:8 You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. (See Also Galatians 3:2 and 14)
- Our Job is to share the gospel for in it is the power that God uses to bring people from death to life. (1 Corinthians 2:1-5)
- We are not saved by our works, (Eph. 2:8-9) but our works are a sign we are saved (James 2:17-19)
- We all struggle with sin, and we will do so until we die, or Christ returns but what we cannot do is not call sin what God calls sin. (Hebrews 12:3-11)
