- All your thinking about how one gets to Heaven must fit the man on the cross (Luke 23:40-43)
- Romans 10:9-10

1) God Rescues us by sending Messengers

2 Peter 3:15-16

- Apostle in broad terms means one that is sent out.
- Paul identifies himself as an apostle repeatedly. (Romans 1:1; 1 Cor. 1:1; 2 Cor. 1:1; Eph.1:1; Col.1:1; 1 Tim. 1:1; 2 Tim. 1:1; Titus 1:1)
- Acts 9:15 Paul was a chosen instrument by Christ
- Colossians 1:1-2; 1 Thessalonians 5:27 show that Paul's letters were written to and read to the church, showing that they would have been read alongside the Old Testament scripture showing their authority. (Col. 3:16 and 1 Tim. 4:13)
- 1 Corinthians 14:37 Paul said that his writings are the command of the Lord.
- 2 Corinthians 2:17; 13:3 and Gal. 4:14 Paul claims to be speaking in the name of Christ with words taught to him by the Spirit (1 Cor. 2:13)
- An Apostle Had to be an eyewitness to Christ Resurrection (Acts 1:21-22; 2:32; 3:15) which Paul did (Acts 9:1-18)
- Revelation 21:14 shows in Heaven the 12 Apostles hold a special place.

- One of the core beliefs of Christianity is that Jesus rose physically from the dead. (1 Cor. 15)
- We are called to grow in our faith in Christ (Eph. 4:15-16; 1 Pet. 2:2)

Mark 10:45

- Grace means unmerited favor
- Peace comes from understanding the grace of God.
- 1 Corinthians 15:3 Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures
- Romans 3:23 All People have sinned.
- Romans 6:23 Death is the punishment for sin
- Galatians 3:13 Jesus took our curse
- 2 Corinthians 5:21 Jesus took our sins and gave us His righteousness.
