Word of the Day: Know/ Known

- Galatians 2:16, Galatians 5:1

1) Those Who Do Not Know God Are Still Enslaved.

John 8:31-34, 1 Corinthians 10: 19-20, Romans 1:21-23

- Because they do not know God they are under sin (3:22) held captive under the law (3:23) imprisoned by the elements of the world (4:3)
- When you sacrifice things to earn the favor of God you are not sacrificing them to the true God but the gods of this world who have led you astray.

2) The Real Question is if God Knows You?

Matthew 7:21-23, Luke 15:19-24, Luke 7:25-32, Romans 14:5-7, Colossians 2:16-17, John 17:3

- To know God is not just about intellectual ascent because to know is personal intimacy
- Psalm 149:4 The Lord delights in His people
- Deuteronomy 26:18 You are a treasured possession
- Isaiah 43:4 Precious to Him.
- Zephaniah 3:17 rejoices over you.
- Isaiah 49:16 we are graven on the palms of Gods Hands
- John 10:14-15 and 27-28 God knows us
- Paul was calling “works salvation” a doctrine of demons.
- Observing Days and months and Seasons and years

3) Those Who are Known by God Endure

2 Peter 2:22, Ephesians 1:13-14, 1 John 2:19

- They believed the law would bring them closer to perfection, but our perfection is found in Christ and Christ alone (2 Cor. 5:21)
- A true Christian is not one who attended church, got baptized, took communion or said a prayer. A true Christian has the Holy Spirit living in them. (Ephesians 1:13-14)
- Jude 1:24-25 God can keep us from stumbling
- Philippians 1:6 God is the one who will carry on the work in you.

Closing

John 6:28-29, Galatians 2:16

- Acts 16:31 Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and you will be saved.
- Are you trusting in the finished work of Jesus Christ or your own works in order to be saved?

The Lords Supper

Luke 22:17-20, Exodus 12:13, Matthew 26:39, John 3:36

- The Lord's supper was instituted by Christ at the conclusion of the Passover meal (Matthew 26:26-29)
- Hebrews 9:22 says without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness for sin.
- Jesus used the Passover meal as an example of Him being the Passover lamb.
