NOTES

How does the Apostles' Creed's emphasis on Jesus' suffering, death and resurrection help you understand the pivotal importance of Jesus' death and resurrection?

How does knowing that Jesus' tomb was empty on the third day encourage you in your faith (Mark 16:4-8 / Matthew 28:9-11)?

Does the fact that there is spiritual conflict always happening, which cannot be seen change the way you view current events (Daniel 10:13)? Why or why not?
