For Reflection and Application:

Monday:

Read 1 Thessalonians 5:12-13a. How specifically can you respect and esteem church leaders?

Tuesday:

Read 1 Thessalonians 5:13b. How specifically can you be at peace with those who seem to antagonize you?

Wednesday:

Read 1 Thessalonians 5:14. How specifically can you admonish the idle, encourage the fainthearted, and help the weak, being patient with them all?

Thursday:

Read 1 Thessalonians 5:15. How specifically can you do good to evildoers instead of seeking revenge?

Friday:

All the directives in 1 Thessalonians 5:12-15 come as an explanation of how believers can be ready for the day of the Lord in the immediately preceding context. How is our response to difficult people in the church a reflection of our readiness for the Lord?
