Monday:

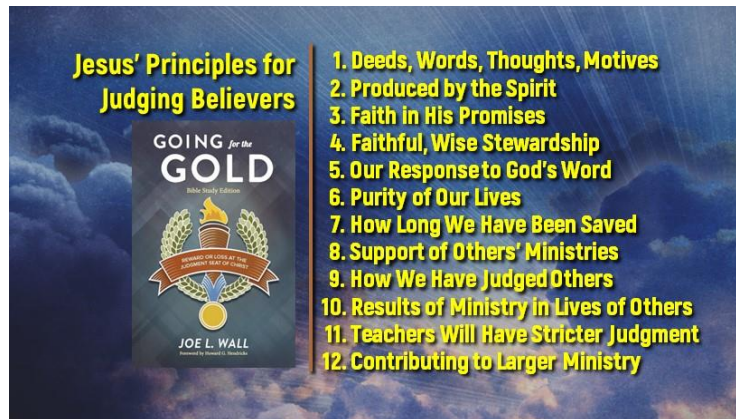

Tuesday:

Thursday:

Read Revelation 22:12. To what extent do Christ's return and his rewards influence the way you live today?

Friday:

Lord, keep sanctifying me. Help me to live in light of Christ's coming that I may be holy and blameless on that day. Amen.
