Sermon Notes

Luke 6:46 “Why do you call me ‘Lord, Lord,’ and not do what I tell you?
47 Everyone who comes to me and hears my words and does them, I will show you what he is like: 48 he is like a man building a house, who dug deep and laid the foundation on the rock. And when a flood arose, the stream broke against that house and could not shake it, because it had been well built. 49 But the one who hears and does not do them is like a man who built a house on the ground without a foundation. When the stream broke against it, immediately it fell, and the ruin of that house was great.” ESV

Big Idea:

Luke 6:46 “Why do you call me ‘Lord, Lord,’ and not do what I tell you?” ESV

For Reflection and Application:

Monday:

Read Luke 6:46. With this rhetorical question, what point is Jesus making? What kind of hypocrisy is in view? How can you apply this to your life?

Tuesday:

Read Luke 6:47. What are the three characteristics of the person Jesus has in mind? To what extent do they describe you? To what does the phrase, “my words” refer? How do you do Jesus’ words?

Wednesday

Read Luke 6:48-49. What do the wise builder and foolish builder have in common? What sets them apart? What does the flood represent and what is the nature of the ruin experienced by the foolish builder? How can you apply this?

Thursday:

Read 1 Corinthians 3:10-15. How does this relate to Luke 6:46-49? How can you apply this to your life?

Friday:

Actively hearing and applying the word of God to our lives brings a stability that is available nowhere else. Why is this true? How does it work? Have you experienced this?

Daily Prayer:

Lord, help me to experience the sense of groundedness and fulfillment that comes from obediently doing what you want me to do, knowing that it counts both today and forever. Amen.
