



Title | Beautifully Out of Step
Series | So You Can Know For Sure
Text | Luke 8:1-3
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Sermon Notes

Luke 8:1 Soon afterward he went on through cities and villages, proclaiming and bringing the good news of the kingdom of God. And the twelve were with him, 2 and also some women who had been healed of evil spirits and infirmities: Mary, called Magdalene, from whom seven demons had gone out, 3 and Joanna, the wife of Chuza, Herod's household manager, and Susanna, and many others, who provided for them out of their means. ESV

Big Idea:

Romans 12:2 Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect. ESV

For Reflection and Application:

Monday:

Read Luke 8:1-3. In what ways were Jesus and his followers beautifully out of step with the world? In what ways have you seen Jesus followers be beautifully out of step today?

Tuesday:

Read Romans 12:2. How does this relate to the example of Jesus and his followers in Luke 8:1-3? How can you apply this?

Wednesday

If it is true that to be collectively in step with the Lord is to be beautifully out of step with the world, then how do you become beautifully out of step? How does 2 Corinthians 3:18 relate? How does John 15:5 relate? Can you become beautifully out of step on your own?

Thursday:

Read Hebrews 10:25. What are some specific ways that you can be collectively in step with the Lord? What is it important to be collectively in step and not just individually in step? Does anything need to change in your life?

Friday:

Consider all the opportunities for growth your church has to offer. (If Moon Valley is your church home, consider the new Ministry Master Plan now available online and at the Connect Counter.) What new things could you do to be collectively in step with the Lord?

Daily Prayer:

Lord, give me the wisdom and courage to take whatever steps are needed to be collectively in step with you that I may become beautifully out of step with the world. Amen.
