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Sermon Notes

Luke 8:16 “No one after lighting a lamp covers it with a jar or puts it under a bed, but puts it on a stand, so that those who enter may see the light. 17 For nothing is hidden that will not be made manifest, nor is anything secret that will not be known and come to light. 18 Take care then how you hear, for to the one who has, more will be given, and from the one who has not, even what he thinks that he has will be taken away.” ESV

Big Idea:

Luke 8:16 “No one after lighting a lamp covers it with a jar or puts it under a bed, but puts it on a stand, so that those who enter may see the light.” ESV

For Reflection and Application:

Monday:

Read Luke 8:16-18. What is the connection between this passage and the parable of the soils in Luke 8:4-15? How does Luke 8:16-18 provide motivation to cultivate good soil and let the word of Christ dwell in you richly?

Tuesday:

What point is Jesus making in Luke 8:16? How does Matthew 5:14-16 relate? How can you apply this?

Wednesday

What point is Jesus making in Luke 8:17? How does 1 Corinthians 4:3-5 relate? What difference does this make in your life?

Thursday:

What point is Jesus making in Luke 8:18? How do Matthew 25:14-29 and Revelation 2:1-7 relate? How is this relevant for you?

Friday:

As believers, we are responsible, we will be accountable, and we will experience gain or loss for our receptiveness to the word of Christ. If this is true, how do you feel about it, and how will you respond?

Daily Prayer:

Lord, help me to be receptive to your word, realizing the responsibility, accountability, and consequences that come with it. Amen
