Big Idea:

Luke 8:21 But he answered them, “My mother and my brothers are those who hear the word of God and do it.” ESV

For Reflection and Application:

Monday:

Read Luke 8:19-21. What is Jesus' primary point? How can you apply it?

Tuesday:

What are the characteristics of a close family? List at least five specific characteristics that come to mind. Are these the same or different for a church family? Read Acts 2:42-47 and Matthew 5:23-24.

Wednesday

Read John 13:34-35 and John 17:20-21. Why is the closeness of spiritual family so important to Jesus? To what extent is such closeness important to you? How do you reflect this?

Thursday:

Read Ephesians 4:1-16. What one thing could you do to contribute to the closeness of your church family?

Friday:

Read Luke 8:19-21 and Mark 3:21. To what extent should you expect some dysfunction in your church family? How should you respond?

Daily Prayer:

Lord, help me to reimagine my spiritual family to be as important to me as it is to you. Amen
