Luke 8:22 One day he got into a boat with his disciples, and he said to them, “Let us go across to the other side of the lake.” So they set out, 23 and as they sailed he fell asleep. And a windstorm came down on the lake, and they were filling with water and were in danger. 24 And they went and woke him, saying, “Master, Master, we are perishing!” And he awoke and rebuked the wind and the raging waves, and they ceased, and there was a calm. 25 He said to them, “Where is your faith?” And they were afraid, and they marveled, saying to one another, “Who then is this, that he commands even winds and water, and they obey him?” ESV

Big Idea:

For Reflection and Application:

Monday:

Read Luke 8:22-25. How could these disciples have had greater faith? How could they have experienced more peace and less fear? How can you apply this?

Tuesday:

Read Luke 8:22. What did Jesus say that could have been a basis for greater faith and peace in the storm? How does this relate to Romans 4:20-21? How can you apply this?

Wednesday

Read Luke 8:24-25. What attribute(s) did Jesus display that can be a basis for greater faith and peace in perilous situations? Read Jeremiah 32:17 and Psalm 115:3. How do these scriptures relate?

Thursday:

Read Proverbs 15:3 and 1 John 3:20. How do you reconcile these verses with Jesus being asleep in Luke 8:23? Was Jesus unaware of what was going on while he was sleeping? What evidence can you cite from Luke 8:22-33 to support your answer? What difference does this make for you in facing fearful situations?

Friday:

Read 1 John 4:16 and Hebrews 13:5. What attributes of God are reflected in these verses and how do they help us trust him in trials? In Luke 8:22-25, to what extent did the disciples trust in these aspects of the Lord's person? To what extent do you?

Daily Prayer:

Lord, help me to know and trust your person that I may experience your peace in my peril. Amen.
