## Sample Daily Itinerary

#### Day 1, Thu, Oct 10: Depart for Italy

Depart Indianapolis for an overnight flight to Venice. Your meals will be served on board.

#### Day 2, Fri, Oct 11: Arrive Venice Airport and Transfer to Padua

Welcome to Venice, also known as, "Floating City of Masks and Bridges". Upon arrival at Venice airport, we will collect our luggage and be greeted by our tour guide. We will board our private motorcoach and begin our pilgrimage as we drive to Padua. This Northern Italian city honors St. Anthony, as the city's patron saint. He is also the patron saint of lost things. Our afternoon will include the University of Padua, one of the oldest Universities in Italy; the Scrovegni Chapel, which holds beautiful frescos by Giotto; and the Basilica of Santa Giustina, the patroness of Padua. Conclude with a visit to the Basilica of St. Anthony, where we will visit his tomb and celebrate our opening pilgrimage Mass. We will enjoy our welcome dinner and overnight in Padua.

#### Day 3, Sat, Oct 12: Padua - Venice - Padua

This morning, we will be on our way to Venice, the "city paved with water" where we will celebrate Mass before a walking tour. Our walking tour will include St. Mark's Square, the largest square in the city and the site of many government buildings; the Golden Basilica of San Marco, known for the great mosaics that depict the Old and New Testament of the Bible; the Bridge of Sigh, a bridge that will bring eternal love to those who drift below it; and additional important landmarks. Enjoy free time in the afternoon and relax over lunch and dinner on your own before we return to Padua for the night.

#### Day 4, Sun, Oct 13: Padua - Bologna - Florence

After breakfast, we will continue our journey to magnificent Florence, known as the birthplace of the Renaissance. During today's journey, we will celebrate Mass. We will take a break for an early lunch on our own in the city of Bologna, known world-wide for the delicious cuisine offered in this picturesque city. Upon our arrival in Florence, you will notice immediately it is a city for all who appreciate works of art. Some of the most world-renowned artists are from Florence such as Dante, Leonardo da Vinci, Michelangelo, Raphael, Botticelli, Donatello, and many others. This afternoon, we will visit the Accademia Gallery with a guide. This gallery, holds the works of artists such as Botticelli, Ghirlandaio, Pontormo, and the ever-famous sculpture by Michelangelo, David. In the evening gather for dinner, overnight in Florence.

#### Day 5, Mon, Oct 14: Florence

Our morning will begin with a walking tour through Florence's storied streets, encountering the city's rich Catholic heritage. Marvel at the iconic Florence Cathedral, which includes three buildings: the Basilica of Santa Maria del Fiore, Giotto's Campanile, and the Baptistery – all located on the Piazza del Duomo. The Basilica's striking dome was designed by Brunelleschi. We will enter the Basilica di Santa Maria del Fiore and witness its breathtaking interior adorned with magnificent frescoes and sculptures as part of our tour, you may visit the baptistery and campanile during your free time. We will explore the Basilica di Santa Croce, the final resting place of illustrious figures such as Michelangelo and Galileo Galilei. We will celebrate Mass as a group and the remainder of the day is free to explore this capital city of the Tuscany region and all it offers on your own. There are many beautiful churches, art galleries/museums, and endless shopping and dining options for you to choose from. Enjoy dinner on your own in one of many trattorias in this beautiful city. Overnight in Florence.

#### Day 6, Tue, Oct 15: Florence - Siena - Assisi

Today, we will take a scenic drive to the Tuscan city of Siena, where we will celebrate Mass in one of the beautiful locations. This medieval city is the birthplace of St. Catherine "Doctor of the Church", and St. Bernardine, known as the "Apostle of Italy". Visit the Basilica of St. Catherine and St. Domenico, here we will view the religuaries that hold the head and thumb of St. Catherine. Our walking tour will include a visit to the Shrine of St. Catherine, which occupies the site of her family home; the Siena Cathedral (Duomo di Siena), the highest point in Siena and dedicated to the Assumption of the Virgin Mary along with the Piccolomini Library which holds beautiful artistic choir books from the 14th-15th centuries; the Basilica of San Francesco, where the Eucharistic miracle of 230 consecrated hosts from August, 1730 were stolen and returned three days later and have maintained their integrity against all physical and biological laws. We will conclude at one of Italy's finest squares, the Piazza Del Campo (location of the famous annual "Palio"). Enjoy free time for lunch on our own before we continue to Assisi, the hometown of St. Francis. Upon arrival, we will enjoy dinner together before retiring for a restful night's sleep in Assisi.

#### Day 7, Wed, Oct 16: Assisi

Today we tour the hometown of St. Francis. Experience the peacefulness experienced here in Assisi where St. Francis began his ministry in the early 13thcentury. Begin at the St. Francis Basilica, visit his tomb, and view a series of frescoes depicting his life, along with some of his possessions. We continue our walking tour through Assisi to the birthplace of St. Francis and ending with a tour of the Basilica di Santa Chiara, which honors St. Clare, the foundress of the Poor Clare Sisters. Enjoy some free time on your own for lunch, and then we will travel to the valley of Assisi and visit the Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels. This Basilica is made up of two structures, both of which we will visit. The first structure, is the "Porziuncola", which is where St. Francis founded his order of the Friar Minor (Franciscans); we will celebrate Mass at this beautiful Church. The second, is the "Capella del Transito", which is the place of St. Francis' death. During your time here, you will have the opportunity to visit the beautiful Rose Garden where St. Francis and other friars lived, as well as the cave where Francis retired to pray. We will visit Santuario Della Spogliazione where Blessed Carlo Acutis' tomb is placed. Carlo is the first millennial to be declared Blessed, he loved the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist and used the internet to teach this to others throughout the world. Tonight enjoy dinner on your own in the village of Assisi before retiring for the evening at our hotel.

#### Day 8, Thu, Oct 17: Assisi - Orvieto - Rome

After breakfast, we will drive to Rome by way of Orvieto. Throughout this journey, our guide will share spiritual, historical, and cultural aspects of Italy. Arrive in Orvieto, a hilltop village with a magnificent cathedral known as the "Golden Lily" of cathedrals for its illuminating mosaics on the façade. The Orvieto Cathedral is home to the sacred linen of the Miracle of Corpus Domini, a Eucharistic miracle of 1263. Celebrate Mass in the Cathedral while in Orvieto and then walk through its charming, narrow streets, and small squares. Our tour will include a typical Umbrian lunch with a glass of Orvieto Classico wine. Following lunch, we will continue to Rome. Arrive at our hotel and enjoy dinner together. After dinner, you may wish to walk over to St. Peter's Square to see our world-headquarters at night. Overnight in Rome.

# Day 9, Fri, Oct 18: Rome: Basilica of St. Mary Major –Basilica of St. John the Lateran – Holy Stairs –Catacombs – St. Paul Outside the Walls

Today we will visit the oldest of the four major Basilicas of Rome. We begin with St. John the Lateran, the seat of the Bishop of Rome (the Pope), then walk over to the Pontifical Sanctuary of the Holy Stairs - the very steps that led up to the praetorium of Pontius Pilate in Jerusalem which Jesus climbed on his way to the trial during his Passion. Fr. Danda will celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Mary Major, dedicated to Our Blessed Mother. This Basilica contains a relic from the manger of the Infant Jesus. After lunch on your own, we continue down the Appian Way, one of the ancient roads of Rome to the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls and the Catacombs. Enjoy dinner on your own, overnight in Rome.

#### Day 10, Sat, Oct 19: Rome: St. Peter's Basilica – Vatican Museum – II Gesu, The Church of St.Louis of the French, San Clemente, Roman Forum, and Santa Sabina

Today we tour St. Peter's Basilica. View Michelangelo's Pieta sculpture, pray at the tombs of St. Pope John Paul II, Pope Benedict XVI and many other popes. Tour the Vatican Museum, where we will walk through the Tapestry Gallery, Raphael Rooms, Map Hall, and Sistine Chapel. We will have free time for lunch before Mass at the Church of the Gesu, the church of the Jesuits which holds the tomb of their founder, St. Ignatius of Loyola and in the right transept is the altar of St. Francis Xavier. Continuing on, we will visit the Church of St Louis of the French, then the Basilica of San Clemente which was built in 1100. End the day at the Roman Forum and Basilica of Saint Sabina. Enjoy dinner on your own and then overnight in Rome.

#### Day 11, Sun, Oct 20: Rome

This morning we attend the Papal Angelus in St. Peter's Square. The Angelus is celebrated each Sunday by His Holiness, Pope Francis (pending the papal schedule). Fr. Danda will celebrate morning Mass and we may visit one of the sites from previous day if needed. Remainder of day is free for your personal exploration and prayer. This evening we will enjoy a farewell dinner together in Rome.

#### Day 12, Mon, Oct 21 Rome to U.S.


After breakfast at our hotel, we will transfer from our hotel to the Rome Fiumicino Airport on our motorcoach for return flight home.
