Saint of the Month

St. Joseph is March's Saint of the Month. St. Joseph was a quiet hero in the Bible by taking care of and protecting Mary and Jesus - his family. Joseph became the earthly father of Jesus, and he taught Him to pray, read scripture, and how to become a carpenter. St. Joseph didn't have to be loud or famous to be a hero; he showed us that heroes can be quiet as he was strong, kind, and faithful.

How can students be like St. Joseph this month?

1. Be Faithful in Small Responsibilities

St. Joseph was trustworthy in the quiet, ordinary duties of daily life. As a student, this means taking schoolwork seriously, completing assignments on time, studying even when it's hard, and being honest in everything you do.

2. Protect and Respect Others

Joseph protected Mary and Jesus with courage and gentleness. Students can imitate him by standing up for classmates, refusing to gossip, including those who feel left out, and treating teachers and parents with respect.

3. Work Hard with Humility

As a carpenter, Joseph worked diligently without seeking praise. Students can follow his example by giving their best effort, accepting corrections with maturity, learning from mistakes, and focusing more on growth than on recognition.
