Dear Parents,

This Wednesday is our Senior Mass for our alumni that will be graduating high school this year. These high school seniors graduated from St. Malachy in May of 2020. This was our COVID 8th grade class that didn't get to present Mary's Way of the Cross, participate in May Crowning and the brunch, go on their class trip, missed field day, and they had graduation in the school parking lot, not in the church. While they missed many of the experiences and traditions during their 8th grade year, it will be very exciting to see them again as we wish them well before they graduate high school and begin their new journey. The ILEARN testing for 3rd through 8th graders begins Monday, April 15 and will continue this week and next. It's important that students get plenty of rest and have a nutritious breakfast as this helps with their energy and stamina. We encourage students to do their best, take their time in reading passages, and check their work before submitting their test. These are skills they can apply to many aspects of life and tests in the future. While the Indiana Department of Education (IDOE) views and presents a school's overall data or passing percentage, St. Malachy teachers and staff look at each individual student's performance and uses the data to determine students' needs and placement for middle school and high school. Our testing schedule for this week is below. The tests are not timed so we make our schedule based on the suggested times from the IDOE and allow students to take their time. We ask that you do your best to not schedule appointments during testing times and be early to school. If students are tardy, they cannot test with their class, must sit in the office, and make up the test at a later date and time.
