Dear Parents,

It has been a wonderful start to the 2024 – 2025 school year. This is our 10th anniversary of our new school. St. Malachy School opened in 1955 on Green Street by Arbuckle Acres Park, and we moved into our new school the summer of 2014. Our parish's history and traditions make us what we are today. We are an Irish parish and our patron Saint is Malachy, who was ordained a priest in 1119. Father Malachy became the vicar of the diocese of Armagh and established in all the churches the customs and practices of the Roman Catholic Church, including the practice of confession. Father Malachy went on to become the Archbishop of Armagh in Northern Ireland. While Archbishop, he introduced Roman chants in the liturgy. St. Malachy was known for his care to the needy as a miracle worker and healer. He was the first native-born Irish saint to be canonized in 1190 and his feast day is November 3rd. St. Malachy, pray for us.

St. Malachy is not a well-known saint like St. Patrick, but St. Malachy Parish is a big part of Brownsburg's history, even if Malachy is mispronounced as Malachi from the Book of Malachi.




