

Kennison's Corner

Dear Parents,

I know the second and third grade teachers and students have been working hard on learning, practicing, and reinforcing the essential reading skills that will be assessed on IREAD-3. Our second and third graders will take the IREAD-3 assessment beginning on March 3. We expect results fairly quickly. In this letter, I'm providing some information about the proficiency levels for IREAD for 2nd and 3rd graders.

<u>IREAD-3 proficiency levels for 2nd graders – what if they don't pass?</u> Second grade students can be promoted to third grade without passing IREAD-3. Since IREAD-3 assesses third grade foundational skills, there is not a "Did Not Pass" proficiency level, instead second grade students can receive the following indicators:

- <u>On Track</u> - Students scoring "on track" are meeting current foundational reading expectations and are expected to pass IREAD-3 in third grade. No additional remediation is necessary before they test in third grade.

- <u>At Risk</u> - Students scoring "at risk" are not meeting current foundational reading expectations and are not predicted to pass IREAD-3 in third grade. These students will receive additional reading support, will be offered summer program opportunities, and will retake the test in third grade.

3rd graders who do not pass IREAD-3

Third graders pass with a score of 446 – 650. Students who do not pass the IREAD-3 assessment are required to take summer school at Brownsburg Community School Corporation (BCSC). We have partnered with BCSC for many years, and we have seen wonderful results. Those students will then retake IREAD-3 with BCSC. If a third grader doesn't pass on the second try in the summer, the student must repeat third grade per Indiana law passed in 2024 and continue to take IREAD-3 until they pass or complete 6th grade. There are a few exceptions to this law that I have listed below. If a student meets one of the exemptions below, the student would be assigned to fourth grade but will take IREAD-3 in fourth grade again.

<u>What exemptions are available for 3rd grade students to be promoted to fourth</u> <u>grade?</u>

If one of these "Good Cause Exemption" situations applies to your student, they are legally allowed to move on to fourth grade, even if they do not pass IREAD-3.

• The student has an intellectual disability or the student's Individualized Education Program specifies that retention is not appropriate, as determined by the case conference committee.

• The student is identified as a Multilingual/English Learner and has received services for fewer than two years, with the ILP committee determining that promotion is appropriate.

 \cdot The student passes the ILEARN Math assessment.

 \cdot The student has been retained twice in Kindergarten through 2nd grade and has received intensive intervention for at least two years.

• The student has already been retained once in third grade.

St. Malachy's third grade students historically have performed very well on IREAD-3 since COVID with an average passing rate of 97% which is well above the state average of 81.8%. If you have any questions about IREAD-3 please don't hesitate to contact me or your child's teacher.
