Dear Parents,

Lent begins next week on Ash Wednesday, March 5, and our school's Mardi Gras (Fat Tuesday) celebration will take place on Tuesday, March 4. We will conclude the day with the "Burying of the Alleluia" ceremony and a blessing of our Lenten Promises in the gym at 2:30 PM. Parents are welcome to join us as we symbolically set aside the word "Alleluia" until Easter.

Lent is a season of preparation for the resurrection of Jesus, focusing on prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. This year, students will pray the Stations of the Cross on the parish campus. In addition to the church, classes may pray using the 14 Stations from the old Green Street Church, displayed in the hallway near the gym, or the outdoor walking stones. Families are encouraged to pray the Stations of the Cross at home and may also use the Hallow app as a guide.

As always, the Knights of Columbus will host Friday Night Fish Fry Dinners in the school gym on March 7, 14, 21, 28, and April 4 and 11 from 5:00 PM – 7:00 PM—a great opportunity to volunteer!

Additionally, the Shamrocks for Life Club will collect donations on Pro-Life Thursdays during Lent to support infants and babies. They are seeking diapers (newborn – size 4), wipes, and diaper rash ointment to assist the Women's Shelter.

Almsgiving


- Cans in Your Hands March
