Our Church: St. Malachy Catholic Church is located in Brownsburg, Indiana. We have a thriving community of over 2,000 families and 7,000 members. Our mission can be identified by C.L.O.V.E.R., Confession, Life, Our Lady, Vocations, Eucharist, and Revealed Word. This simple acronym, through Jesus, is the source for all ministries, activities and events within the church.

Our School: On the same campus as the church, the school has a preschool program, and kindergarten through 8th grades. The school was established in 1954 and currently has over 500 students on a daily basis. Our slogan is "*Learning, Loving, and Living with Christ*". This reminder is for students, families and staff alike. In all that we do, this is our foundation.

The Position: The Registrar and Financial Assistant is responsible for maintaining a variety of student records and transcripts, ensuring families are properly billed for tuition and fees, confirming payments are made in a timely manner, and acting as Sunday collection coordinator. This position manages the Tuition Management System (FACTS) to invoice and collect all tuition and fees. This position is the primary contact to parents regarding questions about tuition, fees, grants, and financial aid. This role requires a high degree of initiative, professionalism, confidentiality, accuracy, organization, and communication skills.

Requirements:

- Ability to work in an occasionally loud environment with frequent interruptions
- Physical Demands include: regularly sitting, standing, reaching, bending, stooping, and kneeling, for extended periods and walking with occasional instances of stooping, stretching, lifting 40 lbs or less.
- Occasional evening or weekend work.
- Ability to process and maintain larger volumes of documentation.
- Must be able to communicate extensively and effectively with staff, parishioners, and community via telephone, email, presentations, written correspondence, and one on one conversations.
- Requires extensive use of keyboard and other administrative equipment.

Walk-ins the day of the clinic are welcome, but we **MUST** have parent/guardian consent if under the age of 18.

Please upload or send the immunization records for the individual who is getting vaccinated.

Please bring your insurance cards. We accept and bill all insurance (commercial, Medicare, Medicaid). **There is no cost to those without insurance, except for the Shingles and adult RSV vaccines,** as there is often a required co-pay.

All CDC recommended vaccines will be provided. We will consult the state immunization registry to assess the immunization needs of each individual. If you would like to refuse a specific vaccine, please contact the Indiana Immunization Coalition at least 48 hours prior to the event at clinic@vaccinateindiana.org.
