Meeting Minutes

4.10.2025

1. Opening Prayer – Fr. Danda began the meeting with a prayer
2. The Council reviewed the minutes from the last meeting. Mr. Dant made a motion to approve the minutes. Mrs. Selby seconded. The minutes were approved by consent.
3. The council discussed consistency with fundraising and ensuring that all groups request a fundraiser through the proper venue so the church can monitor the totality of events in both the church and the school. This includes both raising money and collecting other types of non-monetary donations.
4. School update –
 - a. Enrollment – Enrollment is stable at 524 counting clovers and pre-kindergarten
 - b. The replacement for Mrs. Reynolds 6th grade position has been posted. There are 5 applicants for the physical education opening next year. Interviews for the physical education position are likely to start within the next 2 weeks. A small team will conduct interviews for that position. There will be a need for at least 1 additional instructional aid next year.
 - c. ILearn will begin next Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday. Testing will begin with math and then move to English.
5. SAC Application Discernment – The Council discussed replacing members on the Council who will be finishing their terms. There are 3 to 4 new members that can be invited onto the Council given the Bylaws allow between 9 to 12 members. We discussed which skills would be seen as an asset in a new council member. A recommendation from the Council was made to Fr. Danda and Mrs. Kennison after discernment.
6. School Mission Statement Ad Hoc Committee – Mrs. Kennison will be working with a group of teachers to work on the school mission statement. Mrs. Kennison asked for volunteers from the SAC to be a part of this committee.
7. For the Good of the Cause – Nothing was shared for the good of the cause.
