School Choice Scholarship

Indiana has removed all income limits for receiving a CHOICE Scholarship as of July 1, 2026. This scholarship for kindergarten through 8th grade typically covers 80-90% of tuition. The Indiana Choice School must apply for students; parents/guardians cannot apply for their children. Using the link below, please submit the appropriate documents:

1. If you meet the income limit as seen in on the chart, please upload only the first page of your Federal Income Tax Return with your adjusted gross income.
2. If you are above the income limit, please send proof of Indiana residency.
(Examples: Insurance policy, bank statement, lease/mortgage, utility bill, voter registration, credit card bill, etc.)
