East Hill Church Mother's Day Discussion Guide:

The Transformational Power of Love Through Motherhood

Panelists: Jan, Kimberly, Felicia, and Liz

Date: May 12, 2024

Introduction: On this Mother's Day, East Hill Church celebrated the transformational power of love through motherhood. Jan led a heartfelt and insightful panel discussion with three women - Kimberly, Felicia, and Liz - who shared their experiences, joys, and challenges of being mothers and nurturers. The conversation explored how motherhood reflects God's love and transforms us, and how we can rely on God and community in the midst of the struggles and joys of mothering.

Key Themes and Discussion Questions:

 Motherhood as a reflection of God's love: The panelists discussed how motherhood involves self-sacrifice, generosity, and unconditional love, which mirror the character of God and the love He demonstrates through Christ.

Discussion Questions:

- How have you experienced or witnessed the self-giving, generous love of mothers or nurturers in your life?
- In what ways does the love of a mother reflect the heart of God and the sacrificial love of Christ?

Supporting Verses:

- 1 John 4:16 "And so we know and rely on the love God has for us. God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God, and God in them."
- <u>John 15:13</u> "Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends."
- 2. **The transformational impact of motherhood:** The panelists shared how becoming a mother transformed their lives, priorities, and perspectives in unexpected ways, often pushing them to their limits and revealing their need for God and others.

Discussion Questions:

- How has being a mother, or being nurtured by others, transformed you personally, spiritually, or in your relationships?
- What surprises or challenges have you faced in your motherhood journey that have caused you to rely more deeply on God?

Supporting Verses:

- <u>2 Corinthians 12:9</u> "But he said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.' Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me."
- <u>Isaiah 40:31</u> "But those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint."
- 3. **The need for support and community:** The panelists emphasized the importance of having support, encouragement, and authentic community in the midst of the joys and struggles of motherhood.

Discussion Questions:

- How has the support and encouragement of others sustained you in your role as a mother or nurturer?
- What practical steps can we take to build authentic, supportive relationships with other mothers and nurturers in our church and community?

Supporting Verses:

- <u>Galatians 6:2</u> "Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ."
- <u>Ecclesiastes 4:9-10</u> "Two are better than one, because they have a good return for their labor: If either of them falls down, one can help the other up. But pity anyone who falls and has no one to help them up."
- 4. **Connecting with God in the busyness of motherhood:** The panelists shared various ways they seek to maintain their connection with God amidst the demands and chaos of motherhood, such as worship music, prayer, and relying on the Holy Spirit's guidance.

Discussion Questions:

• What practices or rhythms help you stay connected to God and grounded in His love in the busyness of motherhood or nurturing others?

 How can we cultivate a posture of dependence on the Holy Spirit and attentiveness to His leading as we navigate the challenges of mothering?

Supporting Verses:

- Psalm 46:10 "He says, 'Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth."
- <u>John 14:26</u> "But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you."

Conclusion: This Mother's Day panel discussion highlighted the beautiful, transformative, and sometimes messy journey of motherhood. As we reflect on the experiences shared by Jan, Kimberly, Felicia, and Liz, may we be encouraged to embrace the self-giving love that motherhood requires, to lean into God's strength and wisdom, and to cultivate supportive relationships with others on this path. Let us celebrate and honor the mothers and nurturers among us, recognizing the profound impact they have in reflecting God's love to the world.
