ITEMS ACCEPTED

Clothing: men's, women's and children's clothing, shoes, and accessories

Décor: artwork, frames, silk flowers, knick knacks, candles and candle sticks, vases, statues, lamps

Office Supplies: stationery, paper, greeting cards, pens, pencils, notebooks, rulers, etc.

Entertainment: DVDs, CDs, LPs, musical instruments, sheet music

Books: kids & adult books. coloring books, craft books, religious books, antique books, cookbooks, coffee table books, travel books, maps and globes, magazines

Housewares: dishes, mugs, tea cups, kitchen implements, pots & pans, blenders, mixers, glassware, muffin tins, cookie sheets, trivets, coffee makers, silverware, storage containers

Sporting Goods: balls, tennis rackets, badminton sets, golf clubs and accessories, helmets, biking accessories, swim goggles and snorkels, ping pong paddles, snow boards, skates (but nothing too large such as skis)

Linens: cloth napkins, table cloths and table runners, shower curtains, pillows, sheets, doilies, curtains, rugs

Craft Supplies: paint, scrapbooking items, colored pencils, beads, yarn, floss, knitting needles, gift bags, wrapping paper and ribbon

Sewing Supplies: Notions, fabric, scissors, needles, buttons, thread, seam binding

Personal: make-up, lotions, soap, hair accessories, travel and make-up bags, organizers, mirrors

Antiques: Toys, dishes, décor, ephemera, vintage clothing, paper weights, dolls

Jewelry (even if broken, which we sell for crafts)

Toys: Legos, dolls and doll clothes, stuffed animals, trucks & cars, puzzles, decks of cards, blocks, games, jump ropes, balls

Other: tools, gardening supplies, electronics and accessories, radios, clocks, luggage, backpacks, coolers, pet supplies, thermoses, birdhouses & feeders
