This is a full-time position; however, New Hope will customize this role for qualified applicants based on their availability and expertise.

What You'll Do

- Lead the execution of audio elements for all New Hope events and services, alongside the Technical Director.
- Recruit, equip, encourage, and disciple volunteers on the audio team.
- Produce the signature New Hope sound in accordance with the vision of the executive team and Engineer-in-Residence.
- Receive mentorship from the Engineer-in-Residence and continue to grow in excellence.
- Schedule and ensure audio coverage for New Hope services and events, keeping Planning Center up to date for all audio positions.
- Collaborate with the Technical Director in maintaining and developing best practices for our audio equipment, systems, and spaces.
- Other duties as assigned by supervisor.

Requirements

- • 2+ years of experience in live audio mixing, broadcast audio and/or music production. and the ability to mix live audio to a high degree of excellence.
- • Proficiency with digital and analogue audio consoles (preferably from Allen & Heath) and audio software (e.g. ProTools, Ableton, Waves, and Dante).
- The technical ability to understand and troubleshoot audio networking, equipment, and workflows.
- A heart for serving the Lord with strong spiritual maturity.
- A passion for excellence in the quality of worship production.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills, with a positive attitude for navigating dynamic environments.
- Effective multi-tasking and time management skills, with strong attention to detail.
- Relevant college degree preferred, but not required.
- Workflow may vary seasonally, with large events such as Easter and Christmas Eve requiring more time, offset by a lighter workload during less busy seasons.

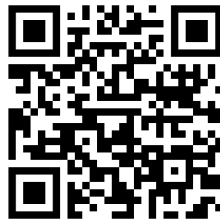
Our Beliefs, Core Values, and Culture
