Quiet your hearts, pray and then read Ephesians 6:1-9 out loud. Reflect on the passage together. If necessary, use some of the questions below to jumpstart your conversation.

Children and Fathers/Parents

1. In Ephesians 6:1-4, Paul addresses generational discipleship in the home. Skim over Psalm 78. Why is generational discipleship important?
2. Read Deuteronomy 6:6-7. What does the discipline and training of the Lord look like at home, on the road (driving), at bed time and in the morning?
3. What are some ways adults without kids at home can be involved in pointing the next generation toward Jesus?

Bondservants and Masters

1. In Ephesians 6:5-9 Paul addresses slaves and then masters. What questions does this passage bring up today?
2. Read Exodus 2:23-24 and Amos 2:6-7. What is God’s posture toward enslaved people?
3. How do you think Paul’s words became the seedbed for the abolition of slavery across the globe?

WIND DOWN | How can we encourage one another?

Split your group into two. Have one group pray that kids and students in our church would know and serve Christ, and the other pray for freedom for people across the globe who are still exploited and trafficked today.
