1. How does the resurrection affect you?

**We live in a world with lots of religious options.**

1. What makes you want to remain faithful to God?

### WIND DOWN | How can we encourage one another?

1. Ask God to fill you with a vision of your future resurrection in Christ. Pray that He'll help you “live life backward” in light of your great hope.
