GET READY | How can I come prepared?

David describes “wise rulers” as those who pay homage to the Son.

1. What, exactly do these wise rulers do?

Talk about some practical ways to experience the joy and peace of refuge in God’s Son no matter who’s in office.

WIND DOWN | How can we encourage one another?
