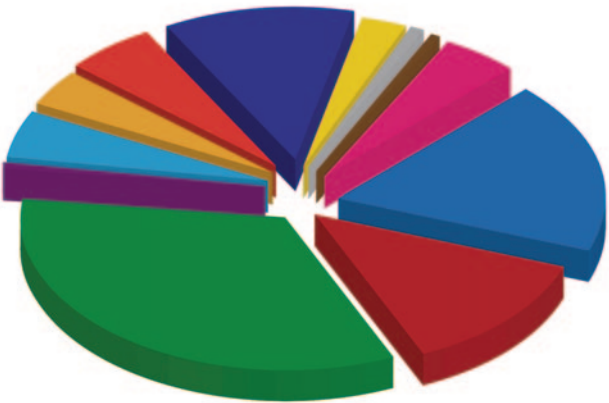
FINANCIAL SUMMARY 2023-2024

La Salle Academy is deeply grateful to our Board of Trustees and to our Benefactors who have made the 2023- 2024 year a fundraising success. La Salle Academy celebrates more than 20 years of La Salle Academy powering the potential in our students and graduates. It was a year of growth. Because of your generosity, La Salle Academy was able to reach our fundraising goals. We are sincerely thankful for your help in making a difference in each of our students' lives. LSA spent \$2,350,000 on general operations, our Academic Program, the Education Plus Health program and educational supports.

Gifts and Donations by Source of Funds

During the fiscal year 2023-2024, La Salle Academy received approximately \$1,900,000 in unrestricted donations,\$1,500,000 in restricted Scholarship and Sponsor A Student funds; \$250,000 in donations and restricted funds for the LSA Graduate Support program. Our Board of Trustees continues to recognize Sr. Jeanne McGowan, SSJ's work and legacy with the Sr. Jeanne McGowan Family Support and Scholarship fund.

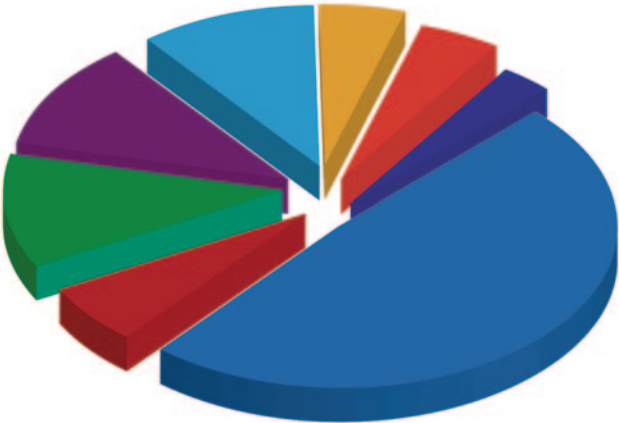
