MY STORY

Who were the primary adults who met your needs when you were a child? Which ones, if any, of those significant needs in your life were occasionally, or frequently, left unmet?

WHAT DOES GOD WANT US TO HEAR?

They laughed at Jesus. But he put them all outside and took the child's father and mother and those who were with him and went in where the child was. Taking her by the hand he said to her, "Talitha cumi," which means, "Little girl, I say to you, arise." And immediately the girl got up and began walking (for she was twelve years of age), and they were immediately overcome with amazement. And he strictly charged them that no one should know this, and told them to give her something to eat. (Mark 5:41-42)

What were the two commands that Jesus gave to these parents after raising their daughter from the dead?

Why do you think Jesus needed to remind these amazed parents to take care of their kid's need for food?

Why would this true story make a solid bedrock foundation for a Christian theology called: The Healing of Children?

What does God want us to hear? Based on the passage and the questions above, what "takeaways" do you think God has revealed to you?

Looking back at your notes from this week's message, was there anything you heard for the first time, stuck with you, challenged or confused you?

What is the one important thing you will take away from this weekend's message or our community group discussion? Is there any challenge, difficulty or praise that you would like to share with the group for prayer?
