WHAT DOES GOD WANT US TO DO?

Pastor Matt said, *“When God came into this world as flesh and called his disciples, he did not call the Religious Elite. He did not call the Pharisees. He called the plain, simple, not good enough people, who had been passed over in life.”*

How would you describe yourself as a disciple?

If Jesus were to give you a designation as a disciple, something that describes what you do for him, what would it be?

How does true discipleship play itself out over a lifetime?

What does God want us to do? Flowing out of our reading and interpretation, what action does this passage or the Spirit’s leading, call us to?

WHAT DOES GOD WANT ME TO DO?

Pastor Matt asked, *“We all have the same decision to make - will you say yes, to Jesus’s call to follow me all of your life?”*

How has this decision played itself out over the course of your life?
