How could you naturally move a conversation with this person toward the topic of God’s compassion for him or her?

What does God want us to do? Flowing out of our reading and interpretation, what action does this passage or the Spirit’s leading, call us to?

WHAT DOES GOD WANT ME TO DO?

Pastor Matt said, “Listen, you exist to make people amazed at the mercy of God - to realize that your Heavenly Father has treated you better than you deserve, and he still treats you better than you deserve. And that kindness shapes us into a kind of people who are merciful.”

To where, or to whom, has God specifically sent you?

Ask the Holy Spirit for the courage and wisdom to accomplish these tasks to which God has sent you.

Take a small step in that direction sometime in the next few days.

What does God want ME to do? What is the personal application and action step God is calling you, personally, toward?
