### **WHAT DOES GOD WANT US TO DO?**

When does the Holy Spirit enter into the life and heart of a follower of Christ?

How do you sense the presence of the Holy Spirit in your life?

What difference does the Holy Spirit's constant presence in your heart make, especially in regard to your relationships?

*What does God want us to do?* Flowing out of our reading and interpretation, what action does this passage or the Spirit's leading, nudging us toward?

### **WHAT DOES GOD WANT ME TO DO?**

Pastor Matt said, *This is the good news of Pentecost: God did not ask you to imitate Jesus without the presence of Jesus. He gave you His Spirit. Which means you don't have to manufacture peace, courage, wisdom, or self-control on your own. The Spirit of God is actively working in you. The same power that raised Jesus from the grave is the same power shaping you over time into the person God created you to be.*

What can you notice this week that's different, because the Holy Spirit dwells in your heart as a believer?

Since the Holy Spirit is truly God, consider addressing him directly in prayer this week. What things would you ask of him?

*What does God want ME to do?* What is the personal application and action step that the Holy Spirit is calling you toward?
