### **Our Vision**



This program was developed to equip emerging leaders who have a desire to pursue vocational ministry. Our residents will receive customize leadership coaching, boots on the ground ministry experience, and intentional soul care.

This is a 1 year residency. Every ministry area resident will work hand-in-hand with Crossroads' leader of that area, gaining experience while developing skills.



### Student Ministry Residency Overview

This Residency is an opportunity for future leaders in youth ministry to gain real-world experience, providing substantial leadership in a supportive environment. Our residents will be challenged to competently execute events, teach kids, manage volunteers, build connections, and grow as disciples of Jesus alongside volunteers and youth. They will also be supported with intentional leadership development that gives chances to shine in strengths and grow in areas of weakness.

staff. We seek candidates who
will be 21 or older by June 1, 2024
and will be able to competently

- Joyfully: As a disciple of Jesus myself, I have a contagious love of Jesus and love for my students that helps me lead fun environments.
- Leading: Through cruciform, self-giving service, I receive God's grace to fight for the highest good of students and volunteer leaders.
- The next generation of women and men: I respect the current life-stage needs of my students, honoring and protecting who they are now and who they will be in the future.
- In whole-person discipleship to Jesus: I work for my students to believe the gospel and apply it to shape all areas of life.
- In partnership with parents: Since parents are the main leaders of their kids' discipleship, I work with parents and support their growth for the thriving of their youth-aged kids.

## **Residency Details**

#### WHAT TO EXPECT AS A RESIDENT

EACH RESIDENCY WILL COVER 3 MAIN OBJECTIVES:
MINISTRY DEVELOPMENT, LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT AND SOUL CARE FOUNDATIONS

- 1 year term
- 12-15 hours weekly (The Students Ministry Residency will be 15-20)
- Compensation: \$20,000/year
- 1 on 1 Coaching from ministry
- 1 on 1 leadership development coaching
- · Customized growth plan
- Flexibility to accommodate outside schedules, particularly for students.

### **Standard Weekly In Office Hours:**

Alternating Sunday mornings: 7:45am - 12:30pm, leading Sunday morning middle school (5 hours)

Sunday afternoons: 1:30pm - 3:30pm in planning and development (2 hours)

Sunday afternoons/evenings: 3:30 - 6:30pm leading CSN, our "youth group" (3 hours)

As scheduled monthly: Leadership Development and Spiritual Direction (1 hour each)

Tuesday mornings (optional): All-staff meetings (2 hours)

Additional self-directed hours for preparation, leader empowerment, and visitations with students

### **Objectives:**

- · Development of personal discipleship rhythms
  - Method: regular meetings with mentor (may be ministry area leader, another staff member, or a longtime follower of Jesus in our congregation) to refine a working "rule of life"
- Proficiency in public communication:
  - Method: individualized coaching in climbing a "ladder" of speaking opportunities with increasing complexity
- · Proficiency in curriculum development: conceptualizing, planning, executing, and evaluating
  - Method: working with family pastor on creating curricular cycle for youth ministry and assessing its effectiveness
- Proficiency in volunteer leadership pipeline: recruitment, development and deployment
  - Method: coaching small group leaders; discipling student leaders
- Development of intentional parent interactions as well as family resourcing and involvement
  - Methods: family ministry conference; participation in family team parent meeting rotations
