WHAT IF I DONT HAVE TIME?

Thats okay! Sometimes life gets crazy! On the far right of each day's plan, you'll find what we're calling the **Express Lane**: a shorter route through the day's reading. It highlights the key moments in the Old Testament story, helping you stay connected even when your schedule's packed. It's not about perfection - it's about keeping your heart moving forward in God's story.

WHAT ARE PSALM SUNDAYS?

Every Sunday, we lean into the Psalms, songs and prayers written by people who were on their own journeys with God. Whether they were on a mountain high or in a deep valley, the writers kept it real with their emotions, doubts, and praise. Psalm Sundays help us reset our focus, remember who God is, and stay grounded in worship before the week kicks into gear. Think of it as the spiritual soundtrack to your summer road trip.

WHAT ARE WISDOM WEDNESDAYS?

Right in the middle of your week, we dive into Proverbs, a book packed with short, powerful truths that hit right where life happens. From friendships to words to decision-making, Proverbs gives us God's wisdom for real situations. Wisdom Wednesdays are here to remind you: this road trip isn't just about where you're going, but how you're traveling. A wise heart makes the journey better and keeps you on the right path.

WHAT IF I GET STUCK?

If you hit a rough patch or fall behind, don't sweat it and don't go solo. Ask a friend, reach out to your leader, or find someone to walk with you. We weren't meant to do this journey alone, faith grows best in community. Keep each other going, one mile at a time.



WEEK 1

(June 1st - June 7th)

Sunday

Before you jump into the reading, take a minute to talk with God.

Ask Him to slow your mind down, open your heart, and guide you through the story ahead. This isn't just about getting through the Bible—it's about meeting God in it. Take a breath, say a prayer, and start the trip with Him in the driver's seat.

Monday - Genesis 1-11

Every Road Has a Beginning - As you read the first steps of creation, humanity, and sin, reflect: Where does your journey with God begin? Where has it been? What patterns (good or bad) are you seeing in your own 'origin story'?

Tuesday - Genesis 12:1-25:18

Pack Light. Trust Heavy - Abraham followed God into the unknown with nothing but a promise. Ask yourself: What does it look like to travel by faith this summer—even when the destination isn't clear?

Wednesday - Genesis 25:19-36:43; Prov. 1:1-7

Family Roads Are Bumpy - Jacob and Esau's story is full of twists, tension, and trickery. Proverbs says the fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom. How do we choose wisdom when things pull us in another direction?

Thursday - Genesis 37:1-43:34

Detours and Dreams - Joseph's life took a sharp turn from dreams to dungeons. Have you ever felt like you were heading in the right direction, only to find yourself stuck or misunderstood? What might God be doing in the waiting?

Friday - Genesis 44:1-50:26

Reunions and Redemption - Joseph forgives his brothers and sees God's plan through the pain. Who do you need to forgive? How might God be using past hurt to shape your purpose?

Saturday - Exodus 1:1-11:10

Pressure Before Freedom - Before deliverance came pressure, plagues, and pushback. What parts of your life feel heavy or out of control? What might God be preparing to set free in you?

WEEK 2

(June 8th - June 14th)



Sunday - Psalms 1-18

Roadtrip Playlist, Track 1 - The Psalms give voice to every emotion on the journey (joy, sorrow, anger, trust). Which psalm speaks to where you are right now? What would your own psalm sound like today?

Monday - Exodus 12-19

Freedom Isn't Just a Feeling - The Israelites walked out of slavery and into the wilderness. What does freedom in Christ look like for you. Not just in theory, but in the choices you're making?

Tuesday - Exodus 20-31

Rules of the Road - God gives His people a new way to live, a holy rhythm for a new life. Where do you need structure or guidance in your own walk? How might God's boundaries lead to your flourishing?

Wednesday - Exodus 32-40; Proverbs 1:8-33

When You Take a Wrong Turn - Golden calves. Broken tablets. Mercy anyway. What does it look like to return to God after a failure? What wisdom can you carry with you to avoid repeat mistakes?

Thursday - Leviticus 1-10

Sacred Spaces, Sacred Roles - In Leviticus, ordinary things become holy (flames, clothes, actions). Where is God inviting you to bring your whole self (flaws and all) into something sacred this summer?

Friday - Leviticus 11-17

Washed and Worthy - God cares about hearts and habits, and about purity and presence. What's weighing you down or making you feel unworthy? Bring it to God and ask Him to make you clean, inside and out.

Saturday - Leviticus 18-27

Marked for a Mission - God called His people to live different; not to isolate, but to be the light. How does your life stand out for the right reasons? What does holiness look like on your road trip with God?

Sunday - Psalms 19-32

He Speaks in Surround Sound - The Heavens declare, the soul cries out, and God listens. Where are you hearing His voice? Through creation, through worship, through your own heart? Are you tuning in or tuning out?

Monday - Numbers 1:1-10:10

Gear Check - Before moving forward, God got His people organized and aligned. What spiritual baggage do you need to leave behind? What do you need to bring with you for the road ahead?

Tuesday - Numbers 10:11-19:22

Still Going, Not Lost - Even in the wilderness, God led His people. Where do you feel spiritually "in the desert"? How is God still guiding you, even when it's difficult?

Wednesday - Numbers 20-26; Proverbs 2-4

When Wisdom Feels Costly - From water out of rocks to serpents in the sand, Israel's mistakes had consequences. How do you respond when your choices catch up with you? What wisdom have you gained through failure?

Thursday - Numbers 27-36

Plotting the Future - God didn't just get them out of Egypt, He gave them somewhere to belong. What "land" is God calling you to prepare for? How are you making space for His promises in your life?

Friday - Deuteronomy 1-11

Don't Forget to Remember - Before entering the land, Moses calls them to remember and to love. What has God done that you need to stop and remember? How is remembering part of loving Him more deeply?

Saturday - Deuteronomy 12-21

Living Set Apart - These laws weren't about control they were about character and community. What rhythms or habits can you build that reflect who you are in God and who you're becoming?

WEEK 4

Sunday - Psalms 33-41

Sing Through the Storm - These psalms remind us that praise and pain often travel together. What song is your heart singing this week? one of trust, of struggle, of gratitude? How can worship anchor you today?

Monday - Deuteronomy 22-28

God Lays It Out - Obedience brings blessing, disobedience brings struggle. What kind of "road signs" has God put in your life to steer you toward His best? Are you paying attention?

Tuesday - Deuteronomy 29-Joshua 5

Don't Skip the Heart Check - Before stepping into the promise, God calls His people to renew their hearts. Is your heart ready for what God wants to give you next? What old fears or habits need to be left behind?

Wednesday - Joshua 6-12; Proverbs 5-9

Winning With Wisdom - Walls fall, battles are won, but not without listening, trusting, and obeying. Where are you trying to fight your battles alone? How is wisdom helping you fight the right ones?

Thursday - Joshua 13-24

God Keeps His Promises - It took years, but the land was divided and God's word came true. Where are you waiting for God to fulfill something? How can you stay faithful in the in-between?

Friday - Judges 1-8

When We Forget the Map - Israel started a cycle: sin, struggle, rescue... repeat. What cycles do you notice in your life? What helps you break out of the loop and stay close to God's path?

Saturday - Judges 9-16

Flawed People, Faithful God - From Jephthah's rash vow to Samson's strength and downfall, things get messy. What can we learn about the character of God, when He chooses to use imperfect people? What's one area you want Him to redeem in your story?

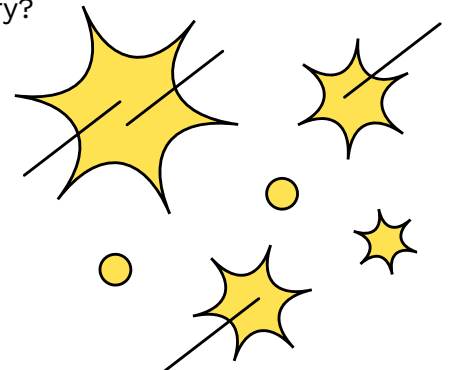

WEEK 5

(June 29th - July 5th)

Sunday - Psalms 42-59

God, Are You Even Listening? - These psalms are full of raw honest questions. When life feels off, do you shut down or open up to God? What would it look like to be real with Him today?

Monday - Judges 17-21 & Ruth

When People Lose Their Way - Judges shows how far people can fall when they stop following God. Ruth shows how one small choice can turn everything around. Which direction are your choices pointing you right now?

Tuesday - 1 Samuel 1-12

Following God vs. Fitting In - Israel chose a king to be like everyone else, but God had a better plan. Are you building your life around God's voice or the noise around you?

Wednesday - 1 Samuel 13-20; Proverbs 10-11

Learn From the Wrong Turns - Saul let fear and pride take the wheel. Proverbs says wise people learn from their mistakes. What's one area where you can grow by doing things God's way this week?

Thursday - 1 Samuel 21-31

Trusting God When It's Uncertain - David didn't have all the answers but he kept moving with God. Are you willing to keep trusting even when you don't know what's next?

Friday - 2 Samuel 1-10

Stay Grounded While You Grow - David became king, but he never forgot where he came from. As you grow, how are you staying connected to God and your purpose?

Saturday - 2 Samuel 11-19

Watch Your Step - David's biggest mistake didn't start with a giant failure, it started when he let his guard down. Even strong leaders fall when they stop staying close to God. Who or what is helping you stay focused and faithful right now? Growing with God means surrounding yourself with truth, not just success.

WEEK 6

(July 6th - July 12th)

Sunday - Psalms 60-72

Praise on the Go - Even when the road feels bumpy, these Psalms remind us to keep praising. What does it look like to worship when you're not "feeling it"? Praise isn't just for the mountaintop moments, it's fuel for the whole road trip.

Monday - 2 Samuel 20-24 & Ecclesiastes

What Are You Packing? - David wraps up his journey, and Ecclesiastes asks what really matters at the end. What are you carrying with you that lasts? On this road trip with God, are you chasing things that count or just idols that fade?

Tuesday - 1 Kings 1-10

Enjoy the View, Stay on the Path - Under Solomon, things looked perfect; peace, wisdom, and success. But even in good seasons, it's easy to drift. When life feels easy, how are you keeping God in the driver's seat?

Wednesday - 1 Kings 11:1-16:20; Proverbs 12-14

Wrong Turns Happen Slowly - Solomon started strong but drifted toward compromise. Wisdom is like using a GPS. It doesn't stop the detours, but it helps you reroute. What small decisions today are shaping your direction tomorrow?

Thursday - 1 Kings 16:21-22:53

Bad Leadership, Broken Roads - These kings took the nation way off course. Power without purpose leads to destruction. Whose voice are you following? Make sure the people leading you are going in the direction God's calling you.

Friday - Hosea & Joel

God Doesn't Give Up - Even when Israel ran far, God kept calling them back. Sometimes He uses hard things to wake us up, but His goal is always restoration. What's God trying to get your attention about right now?

Saturday - Amos & Micah

Don't Just Go Somewhere. Go the Right Way - These prophets call out injustice and remind us that following God means living differently. Are you just cruising through life, or making a real difference? God's road trip is about mercy, justice, and walking humbly with Him.

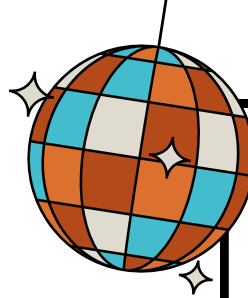

Sunday - Psalms 73-78

Eyes on the Road - These Psalms wrestle with questions: Why do the wicked seem to win? Why is life unfair? Sometimes the road ahead doesn't make sense, but God's perspective is bigger than ours. What helps you keep trusting Him when the road feels wrong?

Monday - Jeremiah 1-10

Don't Ignore the Signs - God called Jeremiah to be a voice no one wanted to hear... because people were ignoring the warning signs. Are there places in your life where you know you're off course? God doesn't warn us to scare us, He does it to save us.

Tuesday - Jeremiah 11-25

Where Are You Headed? - Judgment sounds intense, but it's really God calling people to turn back before it's too late. If your life had a spiritual map, which direction would it be pointing? Sometimes we need a hard reset to find the right road again.

Wednesday - Jeremiah 26-33; Proverbs 15-17

Hope in the Middle of It - Jeremiah speaks truth that no one wants to hear, but also promises hope and a new heart. Even when it feels like things are falling apart, God's working on a better future. What's one way you can lean into His promises while still being honest about the struggle?

Thursday - Jeremiah 34-45

Sometimes You Just Need to Pull Over - Everything is crashing down, and Jeremiah is heartbroken. but still faithful. When life feels overwhelming, do you press on alone or pause to hear from God? There's strength in slowing down and lamenting before you keep moving forward.

Friday - Jeremiah 46-52

God Sees the Bigger Picture - These chapters remind us no one is too big or too far gone for God to deal with. In a world that feels chaotic, where do you see God still in control? He's not just the God of your story, He's the God over everything.

Saturday - Lamentations & Song of Solomon

More Than a Roadtrip - Lamentations is the crash after the wreck (real grief. real pain). Song of Solomon is a picture of love that reflects God's heart for His people. Faith isn't just about rules, it's a relationship. What does it look like to bring your whole self to God joy, sorrow, and love?

WEEK 8

(July 20th - July 26th)

Sunday - Psalms 79–89

Songs for the Long Drive - These psalms are full of honest cries and hard questions (like singing in a downpour). When the road gets rough, what's the soundtrack of your soul? Don't turn the volume down on your prayers, God hears you loud and clear.

Monday - 2 Kings 1:1–8:15

Miracles on the Side of the Road - Elisha's journey isn't flashy, it's full of potholes and people who don't get it. But God keeps showing up anyway. What miracles might you be missing because you're too focused on the mess? Sometimes the breakdowns are where God does His best work.

Tuesday - Isaiah 1–12

Warning Lights Are Grace Too - God's not being harsh, He's waving His arms on the shoulder saying, "Don't keep driving off a cliff." Are you ignoring signs He's putting right in front of you? Grace doesn't always look like comfort... sometimes it looks like a wake-up call.

Wednesday - 2 Kings 8:16–17:41; Proverbs 18

Stay on Route - Israel straight-up ignored God's directions and got lost. It's easy to follow vibes instead of values, but not every voice should be on your playlist. Wisdom means stopping to ask, "Am I still headed where God wants me to go?" Don't just follow the crowd—check who's in the driver's seat.

Thursday - Isaiah 13–23

God Rules Every Road - These nations thought they ran the world but God has the final say. When everything around you feels shaky, remember who built the road you're on. He's not just a backseat driver. He's the One holding the map.

Friday - Isaiah 24–39

Eyes on the Horizon - Isaiah zooms way out and shows us the big picture, a world restored, a King on the throne. Even when your road looks cracked and dusty, God's still leading somewhere beautiful. What helps you keep going when the destination feels far off?

Saturday - 2 Kings 18–25

Even Detours Have a Purpose - Judah's journey ends in wreckage but God's story doesn't. Sometimes we take wrong exits or stall out, but grace is still chasing us down. Where has God met you even after a wrong turn?

WEEK 9

(July 27th - August 2nd)



Sunday - Psalms 90–104

Worship from the Passenger Seat - These psalms zoom out, reminding us who God is and how small (yet seen) we are. Take a moment to stop striving, stop scrolling, and just soak in the view of God's goodness. Let worship be your rest today. No rush. No pressure. Just presence.

Sabbath Week - Rest Stop!

Sabbath Week – Rest, Reflect, Reset

Every road trip needs a rest stop; time to stretch, breathe, and think about how far you've come. This week, hit pause: catch up if you've missed some days, or just slow down and let what you've read sink in.

What's God been showing you lately?

Where have you seen growth?

What needs to be let go so you can keep moving forward with Him?

Rest isn't a detour, it's part of the journey.



WEEK 10

(August 3rd - August 9th)

Sunday - Psalms 105–116

God's Track Record - These psalms are like a highlight reel of how God's shown up through history rescue after rescue. When you feel unsure about what's ahead, look back at how far He's brought you. What are some "God moments" from your journey so far?

Monday - Isaiah 40–55

Comfort in the Chaos - Isaiah speaks to people in exile, offering comfort and calling them back to hope. When life feels scattered or stuck, what truths about God help you breathe again? This stretch of road might feel long, but God hasn't stopped walking with you.

Tuesday - Isaiah 56–66

Bigger Than Just Me - God's plan isn't just about one group, it's about healing the whole world. How does knowing you're part of a global, eternal story change how you live right now? Don't sleep on the fact that your life plays a role in something massive.

Wednesday - Job 1–13; Proverbs 19:1–22:16

Faith When It Falls Apart - Job loses everything and still doesn't walk away from God. Have you ever questioned God in hard moments, or wondered if He's even listening? Real wisdom doesn't hide the pain... it brings it to God anyway.

Thursday - Job 14–31

When Advice Misses the Point - Job's friends throw shade, not support... saying a lot, but helping little. Whose voices are you allowing to be backseat drivers and shape your view of God and yourself? Make sure the people in your passenger seat actually want to help you move forward.

Friday - Job 32–42

Let God Speak - God finally speaks and it's not with easy answers, but with power, beauty, and truth. What would happen if you stopped trying to figure everything out and just listened? Sometimes the most powerful thing is realizing He's still here.

Saturday - Jonah & Nahum

Grace for Me, Grace for Them - Jonah didn't want Nineveh to be forgiven. Nahum said their time was up. Are there people you struggle to forgive or believe God could redeem? Don't forget: the same grace that found you is big enough for them too.

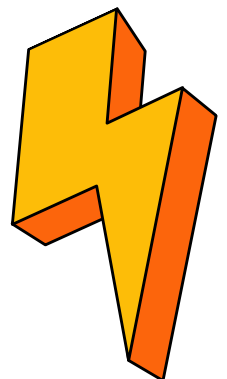

WEEK 11

(August 10th - August 16th)

Sunday - Psalms 117–120

Sing in Every Season - These psalms are short, real, and honest (praising, crying out, and staying grounded). What season are you in right now? Joy, struggle, waiting? No matter the weather, worship still belongs on the playlist.

Monday - Ezekiel 1–11

When the Dashboard Lights Up - Ezekiel gets intense visions. God's glory leaving the temple, warning signs everywhere. What signs in your life might be alerting you to drift, danger, or disconnection? God doesn't give warnings to scare you, He gives them to wake you up.

Tuesday - Ezekiel 12–24

Own the Wreckage - Israel's choices had real consequences and God doesn't pretend otherwise. What parts of your story do you need to face honestly, without excuses? Healing starts where honesty begins.

Wednesday - Ezekiel 25–32; Proverbs 22:17–24:24

Wisdom Bigger Than You - These chapters hit the nations hard. God holds everyone accountable, not just His people. How does knowing God cares about all injustice shape your view of wisdom and justice? Wisdom isn't just personal, it's global.

Thursday - Ezekiel 33–39

Dead Things Don't Stay Dead - God speaks life into dry bones, promises new hearts, and calls His people home. Where do you need God to breathe fresh hope into something that feels gone? This isn't just about restoration, it's resurrection.

Friday - Ezekiel 40–48

God Back Behind The Wheel - The vision of the new temple is massive. Order, beauty, presence. What would it look like for your life to become a space where God's presence feels at home? You're not just building for you, you're being built for Him.

Saturday - Obadiah, Habakkuk, Zephaniah, & Haggai

Voices from the Roadside - These minor prophets speak major truth: justice, frustration, waiting, and a call to rebuild. Which message hits home for you right now: stand up, stay faithful, speak up, or start fresh? God uses all kinds of voices to keep you moving in the right direction.

WEEK 12

(August 17th - August 23rd)

Sunday - Psalm 121–136

Songs for the Climb - These psalms were sung by travelers heading back to worship; songs for the road, for the struggle, and for the climb. When your journey with God gets hard, what helps you keep moving forward? Let these psalms remind you that you're not walking alone.

Monday - Ezra

Start Strong, Start Right - As the people returned from exile, Ezra helped Israel rebuild their lives on God's Word, not just walls. With a new school year coming up, you've got a fresh start too. What kind of foundation are you laying? Spiritually, emotionally, relationally? Don't just restart. rebuild with God at the center.

Tuesday - Nehemiah

Build Through the Noise - Nehemiah had a job to do and distractions all around, but he stayed focused. What distractions or pressure are trying to pull you off mission right now? Like Nehemiah, you've got to build with one hand and guard your heart with the other.

Wednesday - Esther; Proverbs 30–31

For Such a Time as This - Esther stepped up with courage when it counted and Proverbs reminds us that wisdom is bold, humble, and grounded. Where might God be calling you to stand up, speak out, or step in? You don't need a crown to make a kingdom impact.

Thursday - Daniel 1–6

Faith in the Fire - Daniel and his friends chose loyalty to God even when it was risky. Are you following your faith, or just following the crowd? Real strength is staying faithful when everyone else folds.

Friday - Daniel 7–12

God's Got This - Daniel sees wild visions of kingdoms rising and falling... but through it all, God reigns. When the future feels overwhelming, how do you remind yourself who's really in control? You don't need to know all the answers to trust the One who does.

Saturday - Zechariah
