

FIRST AID VOLUNTEER

Purpose:

To provide immediate and appropriate first aid assistance to attendees of Temple's Community Picnic, ensuring their safety and well-being.

Key Responsibilities:

First Aid Response:

- Be prepared to handle medical situations that arise during the picnic.
- Administer first aid for minor injuries such as cuts, bruises, and abrasions.
- Assess and stabilize individuals experiencing medical issues until professional medical help arrives, if needed.

Record Keeping:

- Document any incidents or medical treatments provided during your shift.
- Ensure records are kept confidential and securely stored.

Supply Management:

- Monitor first aid supplies and ensure they are adequately stocked.
- Notify the event coordinator if supplies need to be replenished.

Shift Commitment:

- Arrive 5 to 10 minutes early for your scheduled shift to ensure a smooth transition.
- Do not leave your post until your replacement arrives and is briefed on the current situation.

Qualifications:

- Friendly, calm, and responsible personality with a focus on safety.
- Ability to assess and respond to medical situations quickly and effectively.
- Strong communication skills to interact with injured individuals and their families.
- Punctuality and reliability in showing up for scheduled shifts.

Time Commitment:

- Volunteers are expected to commit to shifts during the community picnic.
- Volunteers should arrive 5 to 10 minutes before their shift and stay until their replacement arrives.
