## Optional Small Groups Beginning in April

Starting in April you are invited to join a small group of 5-7 Pathfinders for weekly prayer and discussion on Zoom, with the leadership of a mentor from St. Bart's. You might think of it like a "lab" or "practicum" to supplement the weekly large group session.

## Optional Online Message Board

Weekly prompts will be posted for online discussion. This is **entirely optional**. Note that your email address will become visible if you choose to participate: There are two ways to access:

1. **St. Bart's Mobile App** — To download, visit [stbarts.org/app](http://stbarts.org/app), or scan the QR code, or search "St. Bart's NYC" in the App Store on your phone. Once you have downloaded the app, sign in with your mobile number and tap "groups at the bottom." Then click on the magnifying glass at the top right corner. Find "Pathfinders Discussion Group" and select "Join Group." Then tap "Messages."



2. **St. Bart's Online Church Hub** — Visit [stbarts.org/hub](http://stbarts.org/hub) and login using the username and password emailed to you after your first class. If you cannot find the message, select "forgot password" and your login credentials will be re-sent. If that doesn't work, you may select "Request a new account." Once logged in, select "Groups" on the left hand side of the screen. Then click on "Pathfinders Discussion Group," and finally, "Messages."
