
Self-Assessment

- RSC gathers information, listens to parish, invites others to pitch in, writes.
- Deliverables: 2 documents required to post position with Diocese and wider Episcopal Church:

St. Bart's Parish Profile OTM Community Portfolio

- * RSC, Vestry, Wardens review, comment, approve.
- Diocese approves, then posts.

OTM = Office of Transition Ministry.



Parish Profile and OTM Portfolio

- Together, they answer key questions, tell St. Bart's story:
 - Who we are. Who we hope to be.
 - Where we've been. Where we are now.
 - Where we hope to go.
 - Who we seek to join and lead us on the journey.
- Answers come from you, the members of our parish community (in person and virtual).



Listening to the Parish

- Parish Survey Sep 2 Oct 2 online, anonymous
- Roundtables Sep 15 Oct 5 in person and Zoom
- Conversations with RSC members
- rectorsearch@stbarts.org

SEARCH & DISCERNMENT

- RSC develops criteria and process, does targeted outreach, collaborates with Bishop/Diocese.
- * 'Receiving Names' starts once Profile and Portfolio post.
- Outreached and received names go to Diocese for vetting, Canon to Canon. Diocese proposes up to 10-12 names.
- RSC sees all names, can add to or pass on the 10-12. Reviews, researches, Zoom interviews, short list site visits, recommends finalist(s) to Vestry.
- Diocese vets finalist(s), Bishop to Bishop.
- Bishop meets finalist(s).

CONFIDENTIALITY REIGNS.

DISCERNMENT & CALL

- Vestry
 - Budget for Rector's package as developed by Wardens.
 - Meet final candidate(s).
 - Discern and decide who to call as Rector.
- Wardens
 - Confer with the Bishop.
 - Issue the call.
 - Negotiate and sign Rector's Letter of Agreement (LOA).
 - Announce the next Rector.

- Pray for grace and discernment for all. Imagine. Hope.
- Trust the process. Trust us. Trust God.
- Take the Parish Survey once.
 Sign up for one Roundtable.
 Online for efficiency, economy & the planet, Survey Monkey & scheduling apps.
