

### Feed My Sheep: Help Feed Families in Pontiac

Kirk in the Hills supports the First Presbyterian Food Pantry in Pontiac with donations of food, funds, and time. Each month, families in need "shop" the pantry for essential items and enjoy sandwiches from our Sandwich Mission. In April, 237 families were served; in May, that number rose to 330 many with children under age 3.

Due to rising food costs, the pantry is facing a severe shortage and will temporarily close in July, reopening in August. Your help is urgently needed.


### The Daily News and The Good News!
