The problem presented Vs 1-2

- 1) Don't be shaken
- 2) Don't be disturbed

The proof provided Vs 3-10a

- 1) Don't be fooled Vs 3-4
 - ✓ A rebellion (apostasy) will occur
 - ✓ The anti-Christ will arise
 - ✓ He will be revealed
 - ✓ He will resist God
 - ✓ He will raise himself up as God
- 2) Don't forget Vs 5-10a
 - ✓ He will be revealed
 - ✓ He (evil) is already at work
 - ✓ He is restrained for now
 - ✓ He will be powerful
 - ✓ He will deceive
 - ✓ He will be overthrown & slain

The pathway picked - Many will choose not to follow Jesus Vs 10b-12

- 1) They reject God's truth
- 2) They believe what is false
- 3) They enjoy unrighteousness
- 4) They face condemnation
