#### **Read Colossians 2:8-15**

### Be certain to not be taken <u>captive</u> by... Vs 8

- ✓ Philosophy & empty deception
- ✓ <u>Tradition</u> of men Mark 7:8-9
- ✓ **Principles of the world** 1 Corinthians 1:18-21; Galatians 4:3

### Be certain you know who Christ is & what He did Vs 9-10

- ✓ **His position** He is the complete revelation of God Vs 9
- ✓ His power He is in charge Vs 10b
- ✓ My position I am complete in Him Vs 10a Ephesians 3:19; 2 Peter 1:3

## Be certain you know the truth about what Christ gives us Vs 11-15

- ✓ Complete <u>salvation</u> Vs 11-13a Ephesians 2:11-13; Romans 6:8-11
- ✓ Complete <u>forgiveness</u> Vs 13b-14 Hebrews 9:22, 26-28; 1 Peter 2:24; Psalm 32:1; 130:3-4; Isaiah 1:18; Micah 7:18
- ✓ Complete <u>victory</u> Vs 15 1 Corinthians 15:54-57; 2 Corinthians 2:14; Romans 8:37-39
