Read Colossians 3:5-11

1) Put to death your sinful passions Vs 5 Matthew 5:29-30; Proverbs 6:27; Romans 6:11-14

The reason Vs 6-7

- God's wrath & judgment Romans 1:18; 2:5; John 3:36
- It's the way the world lives the way we used to live Ephesians 2:1-5
- 2) Put away your sinful ways Vs 8-9a
- 3) Put aside your sinful <u>differences</u> Vs 11 Romans 12:5; Galatians 3:28

The reason Vs 9b-10

- There has been a <u>transformation</u> 2 Corinthians 5:17; 4:16; 3:18
- We are continually being <u>renewed</u> Romans 12:2
