## Discover the **impact** of your new clothes

- 1) Peace of Christ Vs 15 John 14:27, 16;33; Philippians 4:6-7a
  - ✓ Rule our hearts Philippians 4:7a
  - ✓ Reflected in our relationships
  - ✓ Results in thankfulness
- 2) Word of Christ Vs 16
  - ✓ Richly <u>dwell</u> in you
  - ✓ Results in teaching and counsel
  - ✓ Response is worship
- 3) Name of Christ Vs 17
  - ✓ Requires a choice
  - ✓ Resolves do everything for Jesus Christ 1 Corinthians 10:31
  - ✓ Responds in <u>thankfulness</u>
