## The Lord's Promise, Power, & Purpose of Prayer

- 1) The Lord is <u>always</u> at work
- 2) The Lord works on a <u>different</u> time table than we do
- 3) The Lord always answers our prayers
- 4) The Lord has made & always keeps His promises
- 5) The Lord's promises aren't always <u>universal</u> or <u>unconditional</u>
- 6) The Lord <u>invites</u> us to <u>boldly</u> pray and seek Him
