4 QUESTIONS ASKED AT THE TOMB

1st question (the women) [Mark 16:3-4](#)

Who’s going to roll the stone away for us?

2nd question (the angels) [Luke 24:5-6](#)

Why do you seek the living One among the dead?

[Matthew 16:21-23; 17:22-23; 20:17-19; 26:2; 27:62-66](#)

He is not here, He is risen!

3rd question (the angels) [John 20:13](#)

Why are you weeping? “Because they’ve taken away my Lord & I don’t know where they’ve laid Him.”

4th question (Jesus) [John 20:15-16](#)

Why are you weeping? Whom do you seek? “If you’ve carried Him away, just tell me where you laid Him and I’ll take Him away” “I have seen the Lord” [John 20:18](#)

Take Aways

- 1) Don’t believe or give into the lies of this world, your flesh, or Satan that **seeking** what you want will bring you happiness nor satisfaction.
- 2) Who & what you are **seeking** changes everything in your life!
[Acts 17:26-28; Galatians 1:10; Colossians 3:1](#)
- 3) How and when you **seek** Jesus makes all the difference in the world.
[Psalm 63:1 105:3-4; Daniel 9:3; Luke 24:25-27; 44-46](#)
- 4) The time to **seek** Jesus is today-right now! [Isaiah 55:6; 2 Corinthians 6:2](#)
- 5) The Lord promises that when you **seek** Him, you will find Him & He will reward you. [Jeremiah 29:12-14a; Psalm, 34:10; Lamentations 3:25; Hebrews 11:6](#)
- 6) When you **seek** & see the risen Lord, you will be forever changed – you will never be the same! [Acts 2:22-24,29-34](#)

Our Response:

- 1) What “stones” (obstacles) tend to keep people from fully following Jesus today? How have you personally seen God remove obstacles you thought were impossible?
- 2) What are some “dead places” people look for life, meaning, or fulfillment today? How does this question challenge our priorities and pursuits?
- 3) How can grief or disappointment cloud our ability to see what God is doing? How does the resurrection transform the way we view sorrow and loss?
- 4) How would you honestly answer the question: “Whom are you seeking?” How does what we seek shape our decisions, priorities, and lifestyle?
- 5) What is the difference between seeking Jesus for what He gives versus seeking Him for who He is?
- 6) What practical steps can you take this week to seek Jesus more intentionally (through my commitment His Word, prayer, or church)?
- 7) How would your life look different if you truly believed that seeing the risen Lord changes everything
