Be present at Church

- 1) Be in church most every Sunday
- 2) Be in a LifeGroup most every Sunday/Wednesday
- 3) Be a part of Wednesday nights
- 4) Be faithfully serving somewhere
- 5) Be faithful in your giving

Our Commitment to the Church – Every Member Matters

4) **Our Pathway to that Commitment:** **Connect**, Grow, Commit, Go

5) **Our Belief:** We believe that **every member** is called to be a worshiper, a minister, a servant, a disciple-maker, a giver, an **intercessor**, and an ambassador

Our Call to Connect

The Biblical Reason to Connect

- 1) We once were not connected, but now we can be (are) Vs 19
- 2) We are connected by our similarities, not our differences Vs 20
- 3) We are carefully joined – fitted together by Christ Himself Vs 21a
- 4) We are growing together to become temple/sanctuary of the Holy Spirit Vs 21b
- 5) We are all part of the building Vs 22

How do we connect?

- 1) **Belonging** to a church family - Connect in membership (Start Here)
- 2) Being a **welcoming** church family – connect with guests & new members
- 3) Being a **caring** church family - connect in a LifeGroup
- 4) Being a praying church family - connect through prayer by being an **intercessor**
