1) Keep <u>standing</u> firm in <u>freedom</u> v. 1

John 8:36; Romans 8:1-3

2) Listen to the words of warning vs. 2-6

You will lose the benefit of Christ to you v. 2

You will have to keep the whole Law v. 3 James 2:10

You will be alienated from God's grace v. 4 Hebrews 6:4-6

You will lose the hope of future glory vs. 5-6 Romans 8:18, 21

3) See clearly the charade of the false teacher vs. 7-12

They <u>deter</u> obedience to the truth v. 7

They are not from God v. 8

They <u>infect</u> others v. 9 1 Corinthians 5:6

They will be judged v. 10

Philippians 1:6-7; John 10:28-29; Matthew 18:6; 2 Peter 2:2-3, 9

They persecute true teachers v. 11

They should be cut off v. 12
