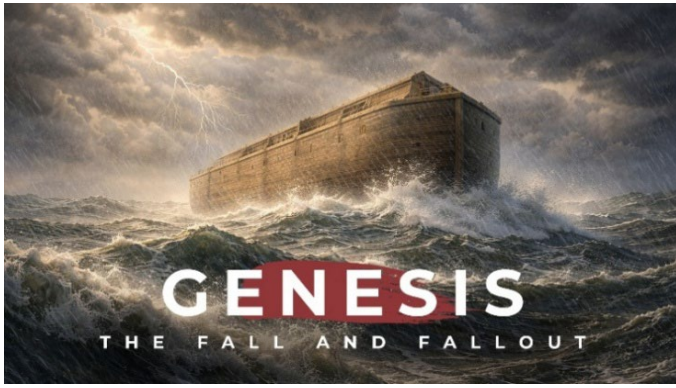

Our Response:

1. Why does Genesis 5 repeatedly record both life and death? What message was Moses emphasizing to his readers? How can the shortness of life motivate us to live more intentionally for God?
2. According to Hebrews 11:5-6, why was Enoch pleasing to God? What does it truly mean to “walk with God” in everyday life? How does walking with God differ from simply knowing about God?
3. How does sin gradually corrupt not only individuals but entire cultures? Why is it dangerous when wickedness becomes normalized in society?
4. Genesis 6:5 says every intent of man’s heart was evil continually. What does this teach about humanity apart from God? Why must the heart be changed before behavior can truly change?
5. What does it mean that God was “sorry” or grieved by mankind’s sin? How can God’s grief over sin help us better understand His love and righteousness?
6. How do these verses challenge the idea that sin is not a serious matter?
7. Why was God justified in His decision to judge the earth? Why is judgment necessary if God is truly holy and just?

- 1) **Enoch waited & believed God** [Jude 14-15](#)
- 2) **Enoch walked with God** his life pleased God
- 3) **Enoch went to be with God** the Lord took Him

The deepening depravity of man 6:1-5

- 1) **The vagueness of the people** The mystery of the people sons of God / daughters of man (3 theories/ideas)
- 2) **The violent victimization of people** – sexual immorality
Marriages
- 3) **The abbreviation of people’s lives** God limits reduces decreases human’s lifespan
- 4) **The vileness of the people culture world**
Evil – men/culture who displeased God decadence decay depravity
debauchery

God’s disgust & decision 6:5-7 God’s decision/decreed/grief disgust

- 1) **God saw the wickedness** – it didn’t escape his notice
- 2) **God was sorry** – deeply grieved – regretted
- 3) **God settled on destroying all life** – including mankind – de-creation

A devoted man received God’s divine favor 6:8

- 1) **His name was Noah** – one who stood out **Exception**
- 2) **It was by God’s grace** [Ephesians 2:8-9](#); [Titus 3:5](#)

Noah – found favor in God’s eyes
Recipient of received
